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ACCREDITATION	The accreditation procedure will take place at the competition hall. <u>Heads of delegation must keep the accreditation schedule, which will be distributed by LOC before the official date of arrival.</u> Heads of delegation have to bring to the accreditation office: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• passports of all participants• national anthem• national flag• 1 USB per NF, NOT per routine – the file should be named correctly – BUL(country code)_Nikolova(gymnast last name)_Ball(routine)• Certification of insurance for all delegation members covering illness, accidents and repatriation – on paper, to be shown at accreditation.• Proof for full payment towards the LOC (copy of the SWIFT to be given to the LOC)• A declaration for use of personal data for all delegation members – on paper and signed by the HoD, or on email and signed and stamped by the NF. The declaration will be distributed in due time by LOC. In addition, in order to receive accreditation, music form must be filled out and sent online by 06 March 2026. LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The LOC will arrange the local transportation (i.e. from/to the airport, railway station and/or bus station as well as from/to the hotel and the Venue) to all participating NFs, who have booked their accommodation and meals through LOC.</p> <p>The local transport is ensured from the official day of arrival to the official day of departure.</p>
