AGE LIMITS	<p>Junior Individual and Junior Group, as per FIG technical regulations</p> <p>Senior individual and Senior Group, as per FIG technical regulations</p> <p>All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.</p>						
JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline (RGI and/or RGG).</p> <p>The participating Member Federations must provide minimum one qualified judge as mentioned above.</p> <p>Failure to do so will result a fine of 1500€ - to be paid to the LOC.</p>

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ENTRY FEES	<p>The non-reimbursable registration fees to be paid to the LOC are of:</p> <p>80€ per Individual Gymnast</p> <p>200€ Group Gymnasts</p>						
ACCREDITATION	<p>Accreditation cards will be distributed at the Accreditation Centre situated at the Competition Venue upon arrival of the delegations. The following items will be checked there with the Heads of delegations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The passport of gymnasts and all members of the delegations • Fulfilment of all financial obligations • Transport – Departure • The medical insurance for the members of the delegations • USB of the music for each apparatus (example: GEO_SALOME_PAZHAVA_HOOP) MP3 format. • National anthem and national flag <p>In order to accelerate the process of the accreditation, each participating Federation is kindly requested to upload photos and passport copy of each member of its delegation (gymnasts, head of delegation, team manager, judges, coaches, medical staff and etc.)</p> <p>In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p>						
EVENT FORMAT	<p>Junior Individuals</p> <p>Qualifying competition with Team ranking</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - each gymnast must perform at least one (1) routine - each NF has the right to choose the number of routines to be performed per its gymnast - each NF has the right to choose the apparatus to be performed per its gymnast - the minimum number of routines per gymnast is 1, the maximum is 4 routines - the maximum number of routines per NF is 4 in total, i.e. one (1) per apparatus - the results of the 4 exercises will be added. The team with the highest score in total of 4 exercises will be awarded with the winner title. 						

NF with only 1 gymnast cannot participate in the Team ranking. The participating federations can have more than one team in the competition, but only one team with the highest result will be taken into account while defining the prize-winners.

Apparatus Finals

The best eight (8) gymnasts of the Qualifications on each of the 4 apparatus of the programme will participate in the Individual Apparatus Finals, no matter if they participate with or without a Team. Only one gymnast per country can participate in the Apparatus Finals.

Junior Groups (5 Balls and/or 5 Ribbons)

Qualifying competition with All-Around ranking

-Group competition (5-6 gymnasts) with 1 or 2 exercises. Reserve gymnast should perform at least one routine.

-The results of the 2 exercises will be added. The group with the highest result after the 2 exercises, is awarded with the winner title. The participating federations can have more than one group in the competition, but only one group with the highest result will be taken into account while defining the prize- winners in the All-Around.

If NF`s group executes only one exercise, she can take part in the Apparatus Final.

Apparatus Finals

The best 8 Groups are qualified for the Apparatus Finals. NF may participate with only 1 exercise in each final.

Senior Individuals (Hoop – Ball – Clubs – Ribbon)

Qualifying competition with Team (**2-3 gymnasts** per team) and All-Around ranking.

The gymnasts present maximum **8 exercises (2 hoops, 2 balls, 2 clubs, 2 ribbons)**. A gymnast may participate in 1 – 4 exercises. If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, she must present 4 exercises. NF with only 1 gymnast can participate in the qualifying competition and All-Around ranking but not in the Team ranking. The result of 3 best scored exercises will be added to All-Around ranking. In the All-Around ranking 1 gymnast per country can be awarded according to the result of qualifying competition.

The participating federations can have more than one team in the competition, but only one team with the highest result will be taken into account while defining the prize-winners.

Apparatus Finals

The best eight (8) gymnasts of the Qualifications on each of the 4 apparatus of the programme will participate in the Individual Apparatus Finals, no matter if they participate with or without a Team.

Only one gymnast per country can participate in the Apparatus Finals.

Senior Groups (5 Balls, 3 Hoops & 2 pairs of Clubs)

Group competition (5-6 gymnasts) with 2 different exercises, one executed with 1 apparatus, the other with 2 types of apparatus, according to the FIG program for the respective year. Reserve gymnast perform at least one routine. The group with the highest score in the All-Around competition is awarded with the winner title.

The All-Around competition is also a qualifying competition for the Apparatus final.

The participating federations can have more than one team in the competition, but only one team with the highest result will be taken into account while defining the prize-winners in the All-Around.

Apparatus Finals

The best 8 Groups are qualified for the Apparatus Finals. NF may participate with only 1 exercise in each final.

INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in the event of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation, or similar occurrences.</p> <p>In accordance with the FIG Technical Regulations, all participating Federations are responsible for ensuring that all Delegation Members have valid insurance coverage for illness, accidents, and repatriation during the entire duration of their stay.</p> <p>It is mandatory that Delegation Members are covered by basic insurance (covering sickness, accident, and repatriation) in their country of residence, in order to benefit from coverage by the FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance.</p> <p>For detailed information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges, please refer to: https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php</p> <p>The LOC will verify insurance coverage upon arrival. INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The LOC will meet and see of the official members of the delegations at Tbilisi International Airport (TBS), provided that their accommodation was booked through the Organizing Committee.</p> <p>The Travel Details must be submitted to the LOC (pazhavacup@gmail.com) by 10 April, 2026.</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. The LOC will provide local transportation for all participants (from/to Tbilisi International Airport (TBS) as well as from/to the hotel and Competition hall and the Event, Training, and Warm-up.</p> <p>The cost - 65 EUR (<u>per Delegation Member</u>) for the local transportation, must be paid to the LOC by 10 April, 2026.</p>
