

JUDGES AND JURIES	The main judge of the tournament is Natalia RENTEL. Each NF may register one FIG-brevetted judge for the competition in which its gymnast will participate (RGI and/or RGG). A group may only register one (1) judge with a valid category of RGG FIG brevet There will be a 300 USD charge if a delegation does not present a judge. All judges must have a current, valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline.

INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC, and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities arising from accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation, and similar events.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations stipulate that all participating Federations are responsible for arranging their own valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents, and repatriation for all members of their Delegation.</p> <p>Basic insurance (sickness, accident, and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. The LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g., cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). 	<p>These measures are in place to ensure a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all participants throughout the event.</p>												
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the international travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by February 20, 2026.</p>												
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>Local transportation costs will be covered by the LOC. The LOC will take charge of transportation costs for all accredited people, from the airport of Bishkek to official hotels and back, from official hotels to the Gazprom Sport Hall and back, only if hotel reservations are made through the LOC.</p>												
ACCOMMODATION	<p>The hotel prices are per room per night, include breakfast, and city taxes are as follows:</p> <p>Category 1 Hotel ****</p> <p>230 USD (single room, breakfast included) 280 USD (double room, breakfast included)</p> <p>Category 2 Hotel ***</p> <p>150 USD (single room, breakfast included) 180 USD (double room, breakfast included)</p> <p>The “low cost” Hotel:</p> <p>120 USD (double room, breakfast included) 150 USD (triple room, breakfast included)</p> <p>There are no single rooms in a “low-cost” hotel.</p> <p>While the Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC by 1 February 2026 at the very latest, the Hotel rooms will be allocated on a “first come, first serve” basis.</p> <p>The costs for the accommodations must be paid 50% to the LOC by bank transfer by 1 February 2025.</p> <p>The Hotel rooms will be allocated on a “first-come, first-served” basis.</p> <p>*Note: the above-mentioned hotel prices are valid before the accommodation deadline, which is 1 February 2026.</p> <p>The Accommodation Form must be sent to the email by 1 February at the very latest.</p> <p>The costs for the accommodations must be paid to the LOC as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At the time of the Definitive Entry (1 February), 50% of the accommodation costs. - The remaining amount can be paid through a bank before 20 February, 2026. Proof of payment must be shown to the LOC sent by email. <p>The hotel prices will increase automatically.</p>												
MEALS	<p>Breakfast is included in the price of each room. The Meal Plan (lunch and dinner) is not compulsory, and the delegations are free to make their own meal arrangements for lunch and dinner.</p> <p>Free lunch will be provided for judges during the competition in the gym.</p>
