Artistic Gymnastics Procedures:

Order of selection

- Difficulty judges
- Execution judges
- Reserve judges

Rules for all judges nominated

- The maximum age is 36 years for Men's Artistic Gymnastics (MAG) and 35 years for Women's Artistic Gymnastics (WAG), attained in the year of the Games.
- Judges in good standing, with a maximum of one judge per NOC is permitted.
- No individual serving as a Federation President or Secretary General at the time of nomination through to the conclusion of the 2026 Youth Olympic Games in Dakar shall be eligible.
- No individual who has received a warning letter or sanction during the current cycle shall be eligible.

Additional NTOs positions

| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must have proficiency in English. |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• In the event that there are not enough individuals from the Host Federation, additional individuals may be invited, with priority given to those from the Host Continental Union. |
