This European Cup will be organised following the current valid FIG & European Gymnastics Statutes, Technical Regulations (TR), RG Code of Points and Newsletters, FIG General Judges Rules, FIG Specific Judges Rules, FIG Anti-Doping Rules, European Gymnastics Medical Guidelines, the Medical Organisation of FIG Competitions and Events, the FIG Framework for Safeguarding Athletes and other Participants from Harassment and abuse in Sport during Events, the FIG Licence Rules, European Gymnastics Media Rules, FIG Apparatus Norms, FIG Advertising and Publicity Rules, FIG Rules for Sanctioning (approval) of International Events and European Gymnastics Accreditation Directives, FIG Code of Ethics as well as all other Rules and Guidelines valid starting 01 January 2026 onwards, any possible amendments by the date of this European Cup, and any complements decided in the meantime.

5. PARTICIPATION RIGHT & ACCREDITATIONS

Gymnasts holding a valid FIG license until the end of the competitions, and with the correct age from FIG affiliated Federations in good standings, may take part in this European Cup. An individual is entitled to only one accreditation card. If an individual has several valid “accreditable” functions, the highest function is normally selected, and the access zones of the functions are cumulated. No substitutes may directly benefit from unused accreditations. The functions of a judge and gymnast cannot be combined with any other function.

Participation right for Senior Individual Competitions:

- 1 – 2 gymnasts

Participation right for Senior Groups Competitions:

- 5 – 6 gymnasts.

Participation right for Junior Individual Competitions:

- 1 – 4 gymnasts.

Participation right for Junior Groups Competitions:

- 5 – 6 gymnasts.

5.2 Accreditation Application Process

Accreditation cards will be distributed at the Accreditation Centre situated at the Competition Venue upon arrival of the delegations.

The following items will be checked there with the Heads of delegations:

- The passport of gymnasts and judges including all members of the delegations
- Transport – Departure
- The medical insurance for the members of the delegations, except from the gymnasts and judges, see point 20.
- Prove of the fulfilment of all financial obligations to the LOC
- Music check
- Check of national anthem and national flag

In order to accelerate the process of the accreditation, each participating Federation is kindly requested to upload photos and passport copy of each member of its delegation (gymnasts, head of delegation, team leaders, coaches, judges, doctor, physiotherapist) into the SmartScoring digital platform (the link and sign in details will be sent to the participating delegations after the definitive entry's deadline).

Photograph technical requirements

The photograph must adhere to the following requirements:

- JPG format ONLY
- Be vertical orientation
- Have adequate space between face/shoulders and the edges of the photograph
- Should have a minimum size of 100KB and maximum of 2MB
- The face should be at least 300 pixels wide

The deadline for the photos & passport copies upload (identity colour photo in JPG format, size – 45mm x 35mm, resolution: 800x600px) is **March 26, 2026**. Please clearly indicate the corresponding full name (with correct spelling) in the file title.

Submission of photos in due time will prevent the delegations from waiting at the accreditation centre. In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.

6. AGE LIMIT OF GYMNASTS

Juniors: born in 2011 or 2012 (as per FIG technical regulations)

Seniors: born in 2010 or earlier (as per FIG technical regulations)

7. REGISTRATIONS & ENTRY FEES

Registrations can only be made by FIG affiliated federations in good standing.

European Federations: Please use the [registry.gymdata platform](https://registry.gymdata.platform) and the login details of your federation. The platform will be open for this event by Friday, February 06, 2026.

7.1 Definitive Registration

The definitive registrations must be completed by entering the composition of the delegation by **Thursday, February 26, 2026 (23:59 Swiss time)** at the very latest.

7.2 Nominative Registration

The nominative registrations must be completed by entering the delegation members names by **Thursday, March 26, 2026 (23:59 Swiss time)** at the very latest.

Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards European Gymnastics or FIG (e.g. annual membership fees, unpaid invoices etc.) and the LOC (e.g. accommodation, meals) will not be allowed to participate in this European Cup.

Once transferred, the entry fee is non-refundable. In case of non-participation or partial participation the entry fee will not be reimbursed.

9. LICENSES

All gymnasts must have a valid FIG license until the end of the event.

In order to be considered, license application forms (new or renewal) must be submitted to the FIG at least one (1) month prior to the deadline for the nominative registration.

Please consult FIG Licence Rules for additional information.

Coaches must have a valid coach-sport profile on the FIG website and must have completed the Safeguarding course on the FIG E-Learning Platform. *Please complete these steps in due time before the nominative entries' deadline.*

10. JUDGES

All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, in the respective discipline RGI and/or RGG.

Each NF may send RGI and/or RGG FIG brevetted judge(s) category 1, 2, 3, 4.

If a federation does not enter a judge as listed above, a fine of EUR 5'000 - per missing judge must be paid to the LOC, to cover costs for the invitation of a neutral judge instead.

Judges shall recuse themselves if

- They are or were married to or live in a registered partnership or co-habit with a gymnast
- They are related to a gymnast by birth or marriage in direct or in collateral line, including the following persons: grandparent, parent, uncle, aunt, brother, sister, child, grandchild, nephew and cousin.



11. DRAWING OF LOTS

The gymnasts' drawing of lots will decide the starting order of the qualification competitions and the finals. It will be held by the LOC after the nominative entries' deadline.

12. COMPETITION FORMAT & PROGRAMME

Senior Individuals (Hoop – Ball – Clubs – Ribbon)

Qualifying competition for Cross Battles and Apparatus Finals

- **1-2 gymnasts** per NF
- The gymnasts present **minimum 4 and maximum 8 exercises** with the apparatus according to the FIG program for the respective year. A gymnast may participate in 1 – 4 exercises
- If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, the gymnast must present 4 exercises
- **Qualification for the AA Cross-Battles** – the **best 4 scores** count (**max. 2** gymnasts per NF)

Apparatus Finals Ranking Senior Individuals

Separate apparatus finals for Senior RGI will not take place. The best 3 Senior Individuals, Maximum 1 gymnast per NF, will be awarded medals per apparatus from the qualification competition.

Cross Battles Senior Individuals

- Best 16 gymnasts from the qualification all-around ranking, *maximum 2 gymnasts per NF*
- Knock-out competition in 4 stages: best 16 / best 8 / best 4 / fight for medals (3rd & 4th and 1st & 2nd)
- The winner of the Cross Battles is awarded with the title "European Cup Champion "

Senior Groups (5 Balls ; 3 Hoops & 2 pairs of Clubs)

Qualifying competition for Cross Battles and Apparatus Finals

- Group competition (5-6 gymnasts) with 2 different exercises, one executed with 1 apparatus, the other with 2 types of apparatus, according to the FIG program for the respective year.
- The All-Around competition is a qualifying competition for the AA Cross Battles and the Apparatus finals

Apparatus Finals

Separate apparatus finals for Senior RGG will not take place. The best 3 Senior Groups with each apparatus (5 Balls ; 3 Hoops & 2 pairs of Clubs) will be awarded medals per apparatus from the qualification competition.

Cross Battles Senior Groups

- Best 6 Groups from the qualification all-around ranking
- Knock-out competition in 2 stages: best 6 / fight for medals (1st & 2nd & 3rd)
- The winner of the Cross Battles is awarded with the title "European Cup Champion "

Junior Individuals (Hoop – Ball – Clubs – Ribbon)

Qualifying competition for Team Cross Battles and Apparatus Finals

- 1 - 4 gymnasts per NF
- The gymnasts present in total 4 exercises with the 4 apparatus according to the FIG programme for the respective year
- One gymnast may participate with 1 - 4 exercises
- NF with only 1 gymnast does not have Team results
- Team results: the combined results of all 4 scores which serves as qualification for the Junior Individuals Teams Cross Battles
- If a NF participates with only 1 gymnast, the gymnast must present 4 exercises with all 4 apparatus and can qualify for the Apparatus Finals



Apparatus Finals Ranking Junior Individuals

Separate apparatus finals for Junior RGI will not take place. The best 3 Junior Individuals, Maximum 1 gymnast per NF, will be awarded medals per apparatus from the qualification competition.

Cross Battles Junior Individuals Teams

- Best 8 teams from the qualifying competition with team results
- Knock-out competition in 3 stages: best 8 / best 4 / fight for medals (3rd & 4th and 1st & 2nd)
- The winner of the Cross Battles is awarded with the title "European Cup Champion "

Junior Groups (5 Balls - 5 Ribbons)

Qualifying competition with All-Around ranking

- Group competition (5-6 gymnasts) with 2 exercises of 2 different apparatus according to the FIG programme for the respective year. The results will be combined for the all-around ranking for groups who participate with 2 routines
- The All-Around competition is also a qualifying competition for the Apparatus finals
- NF may also participate with only 1 exercise. Groups with 1 exercise can qualify for the Apparatus Final
- The winner of the All-Around competition is awarded with the title "Junior European Cup Groups All-Around Champion "

Apparatus Finals

- 2 finals with the best 8 groups per apparatus of the qualifying competition
- The first ranked group in each final is awarded with the title "Junior European Cup Champion "

- Settlement of the remaining 50% of accommodation costs and 100% of the total meal costs – by **March 26, 2026**.

Cancellation Policy

European Gymnastics and the LOC strongly recommend that each Federation take a cancellation insurance for their accommodations and meal options.

Accommodation:

- From March 12 to March 26: 50% of the total accommodation cost will be charged
- After March 26: 100% cancellation fee of the total accommodation cost will be applied

Meals:

- After April 16: 100% cancellation fee of the total meal cost will be applied

20. INSURANCE

The Host Federation, the LOC, European Gymnastics and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.

The European Gymnastics and FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.

Basic insurance (sickness, accident and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to <https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php> for additional information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges.

All other delegation members are NOT included in this insurance and must present a proof of insurance at the accreditation.

The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy in English writing).

Delegation members with insufficient insurance coverage will subsequently be offered with insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: 5 EUR per person per day / April 28 to May 04, 2026.

21. WORK PLAN

European Gymnastics will endeavor to issue the work plan to Federations and other people concerned six weeks prior to the start of the competition.

23. DOPING CONTROLS

Anti-doping controls may take place at any time. FIG Anti-Doping Rules and the WADA Code valid at the time of the event are applicable.

24. MUSIC & MUSIC FORMS

The SmartScoring digital platform (delegation.gymdata.online) will allow each Delegation to create a profile and upload pictures, music (.mp3 or .wga), and national anthems.

The music can be uploaded as soon as the digital platform is open but by **March 26, 2026 at the very latest**. Musics have to be uploaded in the following format:

File format: .mp3

Name of file must contain:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country)
- The first and last name of the individual competitor
- The category (individual/group);
- The apparatus
- The Junior or Senior (Example: AZE_AGHAMIROVA_Zohra_Senior_Ind._ball.mp3)

Delegation members are requested to keep in their possession a USB key for their training sessions and in case of a technical problem.

Each Federation will also have to confirm that the music used does not violate any copyrights and that it can be broadcasted within sports.

At the accreditation, the Heads of delegation have to hand in the Music Release form which you will receive together with the work plan.

25. LOC DIGITAL PLATFORM

After the definitive entries deadline, the LOC will provide login details to access the LOC digital platform delegation.gymdata.online to all registered federations.

Security for event related payments

An increase in fraud with event-related payments was seen recently. (Fraudulent bank details being shared in hacked e-mail conversations and payments getting lost through that.)

Please take good note of the below and inform any person involved in administration for participation in European Gymnastics events.

Please

- always make sure that an e-mail or link is really coming from the LOC or European Gymnastics (by verifying each letter of an e-mail address / url).
- only pay to bank details included in event directives (published on the European Gymnastics website).
- never accept new bank details by e-mail for a payment.
- if anything looks suspicious (different bank details on different documents / bank details not matching the event host country (for payments to a LOC) / not matching Switzerland (for entry fees payments to European Gymnastics) / different tone of an e-mail text / different e-mail signature) – **do not pay, but contact the LOC or European Gymnastics separately** via known contact details to verify the situation.

For all persons handling administration for event participation:

- regularly change e-mail account passwords
(of your federation's general e-mail address and e-mail accounts of all persons involved in event administration).
- **never work from an open** (not passport-protected) **wifi-net** (in hotels / event venues / airports / trains etc.). Especially not when logging into e-mail account, bank account or online booking- / event- registration - platforms.
- take care of internet security (**always up-to-date firewall, antivirus programme**).
