


MUSIC	All the music will be transmitted to the LOC on 14th May 2026 at the latest with this email: kaa@aerobic.or.kr The LOC wish to receive your music with only format mp3. Each mail/sending will have to contain following information: Category / Nation / (IM or IW or MP or TR or GR and the number and NAME + First name) and each file MP3 joint with the mail will have imperatively to bear the name of the gymnast concerned. (Example: SEN IW_NAT1_FIRST NAME_last name.mp3).									
JUDGES & JURIES	All judges must have a current valid Aerobic FIG brevet at the time of the event.									
REGISTRATION DEADLINES	Provisional, Definitive and Nominative Registrations must be completed by sending the composition of the delegation to the LOC. ENTRY FEES	No Entry Fee will be applied for this event.									
EVENT FORMAT	The Aerobic Gymnastics International Open Competition will have Qualifications, and Finals in all categories. Aerobic Gymnastics Categories: IW, IM, MP, TR, GR, AD, AS. Qualifications: participation is not limited by nation / category / age group. The participation in the finals is limited to 2 units per country in each category.									
ACCREDITATION	The accreditation will take place at the venue upon arrival to Busan. The accreditations will only be handed out to the Head of Delegation. All delegations must deliver 2 memory sticks with the musics of all routines, national anthem and flag, SPORTIVE INSURANCE declaration, passports of all members and FIG Licenses. In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.

PARTICIPATION	<p>The International Open Competition consists of qualifications and finals. There will be qualifications only for the categories and age groups with more than 9 participants. In case of a tie in any place, the tie-breaking rules are as set by FIG.</p> <p>Participation in the finals: The top eight units per category and age group will qualify for the Finals. In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules are the FIG World Championships Rules. The LOC may cancel the competition in the respective category if at the time of the definitive entry, there are less than 3 countries registered in a category.</p>
SIZE OF THE DELEGATION AND FIG LICENSE	<p>The number of participants by nation, category and age group is not limited. All Junior and Senior gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG license until the end of the event, may participate.</p> <p>The LOC will be responsible for checking the validity of all gymnasts Licenses. No gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License until the end of the event.</p>
DRAWING OF LOTS	<p>The drawing of lots will take place at the Korea Aerobic Association two weeks after the closing date of the nominative registration. After publication of the draw to all participating federations there will be an opportunity to modify the position of the gymnasts' starting order within 3 days by using the official document.</p>
MEDICAL SERVICES	<p>The Local Organizing Committee will provide first aid medical services.</p>
VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Korea Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Korea. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 14th, April, 2026 to the LOC. To request an invitation letter, please send the following information to the LOC:</p> <p>Full Name, Gender, Date of Birth, Citizenship, Passport Number, Passport Expiry Date, Function/Role within the Delegation, Arrival and Departure Dates, City where the visa application support letter should be sent. Please ensure that all information is complete and accurate to avoid delays in visa processing.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in the event of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation, or similar occurrences.</p> <p>In accordance with the FIG Technical Regulations, all participating Federations are responsible for ensuring that all Delegation Members have valid insurance coverage for illness, accidents, and repatriation during the entire duration of their stay.</p> <p>It is mandatory that Delegation Members are covered by basic insurance (covering sickness, accident, and repatriation) in their country of residence, in order to benefit from coverage by the FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance.</p> <p>For detailed information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges, please refer to:</p> <p>https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php</p> <p>The LOC will verify insurance coverage upon arrival. Each Delegation must present either a cover note or a photocopy of the valid insurance policy.</p>

	<p>The policy must be valid starting from the day of arrival and must remain valid for the entire duration of the stay.</p> <p>If a Federation cannot provide proof of valid insurance, the LOC will offer in the workplan, insurance coverage at the Federation's own expense.</p>
SAFEGUARDING	<p>From the official day of arrival until the official day of departure, all participants — including gymnasts, coaches, judges, and other Delegation Members — will have the possibility to contact the LOC Safeguarding Officer by phone or email in case of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Harassment • Abuse of any kind • Any situation where they feel uncomfortable or unsafe <p>The contact information for the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be provided to all Delegations upon arrival on site.</p> <p>As part of the FIG's commitment to athlete welfare and youth protection, posters of the "10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics", part of the FIG's awareness campaign, must be clearly displayed in several key areas, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Training Halls • Warm-Up Areas • Public Zones <p>These measures are in place to ensure a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all participants throughout the event.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 14th April, 2026.</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>It is mandatory for all delegations to book their local transportation through the LOC.</p> <p>The Organizers will arrange at free of charge, the transport service from the Gimhae International airport to the accommodation place in Busan and to the competition hall.</p>
ACCOMMODATION	<p>The official hotel is located near venue. The Korea Aerobic Association will have the pleasure to invite all of participating Federations.</p> <p>Accommodation will also include 2 meals (breakfast and lunch) a day.</p> <p>Korea Aerobic Association would be much appreciated it if more people (athletes, judges, coaches, parents...) join us and we would like to kindly inform you the costs of staying with 2 meals (breakfast and lunch).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Single room: US\$ 50 per day • Double room: US\$ 30 per day • Triple room: US\$ 20 per day and per persons

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<p>The Draw for the starting order for Qualifications and Finals will be done in advance by the Technical Committee of Korea Aerobic Association based on the Definitive entries and will be distributed to all Nations. Detailed information for the program, schedules and organization of the event will be given to all participating federation with the Work Plan. Work Plan which will be distributed to all registered federations not later than 29th May 2026.</p> <p>An international event (not FIG sanctioned) will also be held for YOUTH: 12-14 years old and National Development: 9-11 years old in the following categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • YOUTH: IW, IM, MP, TR, GR, AD • ND: IW, IM, MP, TR, GR <p>Delegations have to prove the age of the gymnasts (FIG license, national license, passport, personal ID, insurance, etc.), if requested by LOC. Conditions, number of units, deadlines and prices are the same as for the Seniors and Juniors. For ND, YOUTH competitions only: National judges with highest national category may be also accepted. The LOC may require the proof of the national judging brevet or ask respective NF for confirmation the national category.</p>
