PARTICIPATION	The World Cup Competitions consist of Qualifications and Finals in all 5 categories. <u>Participation in the Qualifications:</u> All competitors must take part in the qualifications. <u>Participation in the Finals:</u> The top eight units per category from the qualifications qualify for the Finals. In addition, if the Organizing Member Federation has not qualified in any category, it may nominate one participation in max. 1 category of its choice. Maximum participation in the finals is therefore 8+1 participants in one category and 8 in the other four categories. Such "Wild Card Participant" must have participated in the respective category in the qualification. "Wild Card Participants" will receive medals and prize money, but they will not receive any World Cup Points. If there are less than 4 units participating in a category, no medals, prize money and World Cup Points will be awarded. In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied. The Organizing Member Federation may cancel the competition in the respective category if at the time of the definitive entry, there are less than 4 units registered in a category. In case of such a cancelation, the Organizing Member Federation must reimburse, in full, the entry fee and payments made for accommodation. Should flights have to be cancelled due to the above, the risk is at the charge of the participating member Federations. <u>World Cup Competitions may exceptionally be combined with other Competition provided those are clearly separated in the competition schedule.</u>
"HORS CONCOURS" GYMNASTS	The Organizing Member Federation is allowed to add only for the qualifications "hors concours" competitors. These competitors are in addition to the official participants of the Organizing Member Federation's competitors, they must be named at the time of the

	closing of the nominative registration and cannot qualify for the final. They will have to start first, they are not eligible to receive World Cup Points and prize money and they must not appear on the official results lists. The Organizing Member Federation is allowed to name 1 Individual Men, 1 Individual Woman, 1 Mixed pair, 1 Trio and 1 Group as “hors concours” competitors.									
FEDERATIONS INVITED	The Organizing Member Federation must invite all FIG Member Federations who have paid their annual membership fee for Aerobic Gymnastics.									
SIZE OF DELEGATION AND FIG LICENCE	The maximum size of each delegation is as per FIG Rules for Accreditation.									
AGE LIMITS	18 years in the year of the competition.									
JUDGES AND JURIES	The number of Juries (judges’ panels) may be decided by the Organizing Member Federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges. The Juries are set up by a draw - directed by the FIG Technical Delegate - from the judges present at the event. Priority will be given to the judges of the highest category. A jury must consist of one Chair of Judges’ Panel, 4 Artistic, 4 Execution and 2 Difficulty judges. A federation may not have a judge on both the execution and artistic panels. The Chair of Judges' Panel and the difficulty judges should also be from different federations. Only in exceptional situations can the Technical Delegate make the decision to deviate from this. For categories and eligibility, please refer to the FIG General Judges Rules, Art 5 If, on the day of the competition, there are no sufficient number of judges in the requested categories, the Technical Delegate may take whatever action needed to secure the running of the event. Each participating federation must provide minimum one judge Cat. 1, 2 or 3*. Failure to do so, or if a participating Federation sends a judge with a Cat. 4 (instead of Cat. 1, 2 or 3) will result in a fine of CHF 2'000.- to be paid to the Organizing Member Federation. *Member Federations who have only Cat. 4 judges are allowed to send a Cat. 4 judge who may be used as Time and Line judge only. The Organizing Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges, the Organizing Member Federation may propose to the FIG for approval the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 1 reserve). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation. Such invitation must be made through the respective Member Federation. Should the Organizing Member Federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the FIG will invite such judges at the cost of the Organizing Member Federation.									
COACHES	No coaches will be accepted in this World Cup without a valid coach-sport profile at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. In order to be considered, the coach-sport profile (including all relevant documents) must be submitted in FIG Database on May 13, 2026 at the very latest (two weeks prior to the deadline for Nominative Registration).									
FIG TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND EC MEMBER	The FIG Technical Delegate and EC member (if applicable) will be designated by the FIG. The FIG Technical Delegate will serve as President of the Superior Jury.									
REGISTRATION DEADLINES	Provisional, Definitive and Nominative Registrations must be made exclusively on-line via the https://database.fig-gymnastics.com/login. 	Registrations and payments made after the gymnasts' drawing of lots will not be accepted and the Delegation members concerned will not be authorized to participate.		
DRAWING OF LOTS	The drawing of lots will take place at the FIG Headquarters in Lausanne (SUI) two weeks after the closing date of the nominative registration. After publication of the draw on the FIG website, the member Federation will be given an opportunity to modify the position of their gymnasts' starting order within 3 days by using the official document to be found on FIG website		
ENTRY FEES	The entry fees, if any, have to be approved by fig. The non-reimbursable cost for the Entry Fee is of USD 84 per gymnast/category. 100% of the Entry fee must be paid to the LOC no later than May 6, 2026. The entry fee is calculated based on the number of units in the Definitive registration. Even if the number of participants is reduced after Definitive registration, the entry fee remains unchanged.		
ACCOMMODATION	True Home Galactic International Hotel -address: No. 34, New Land Alpha Phase 2&3, 1 Xuefu Avenue, Honggutan District, Nanchang City, Jiangxi Province The costs per person/night in this first Hotel are as follows: USD 125.- (single room, including breakfast) USD 69.- (double room, including breakfast) The “True Home Galactic International hotel” is 5 stars. It is situated 5 km distance from the Competition venue/13 min driving. There will be a free shuttle between Hotel and Competition Venue. Steigenberger Nanchang Sunac - address: No. 555, South Longpan Street, Honggutan New District, Nanchang City, Jiangxi Province, China The costs per person/night in this low-cost Hotel are as follows: USD 125.- (single room, including breakfast) USD 69.- (double room, including breakfast) The “Steigenberger Nanchang Sunac” Hotel is 5 stars. It is situated at about 5 km distance from the Competition venue/13 min driving. There will be a free shuttle between Hotel and Competition Venue. Mercure Hotel Nanchang Sunac - address: No. 987, South Longpan Street, Honggutan New District, Nanchang City, Jiangxi Province, China The costs per person/night in this low-cost Hotel are as follows: USD 69 (single room, including breakfast) USD 39 (double room, including breakfast) The “Mercure Hotel Nanchang Sunac” Hotel is 4 stars. It is situated at about 5.5 km distance from the Competition venue/15 min driving. There will be a free shuttle between Hotel and Competition Venue. The invited participating federations must pay for the accommodation expenses of their delegation members. All the rates are per person, per night including BF, all taxes and service charges. Lunch and Dinner are NOT included.		

	The prices charged for the hotel rooms will not exceed the usual hotel rates. While the Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC by April 22, 2026 at the very latest, the Hotel rooms will be allocated on a “first come, first serve” basis. The costs for the accommodations must be paid to the LOC as follows: The total Accommodation costs should be paid not later than May 6, 2026 and accompanied by the official Provisional Accommodation Form. Payment of the Accommodation should be made after information from the LOC for the availability on the requested number and type of rooms! Reservations will only be confirmed if the necessary payments are made!
MEALS	The invited participating federations must pay for the meal's expenses of their delegation members. There is a possibility to order lunch and dinner only for those accommodated via the LOC. The price is USD 26 per meal. All meals are served in the Hotel. While the Meals Form must be returned to the LOC by April 22, 2026 at the very latest, the costs for the meals must be paid to the LOC by May 6, 2026 as follows: Cancellations or modifications of the meals/ number of people are accepted by May 22, 2026. The LOC will reimburse 100% of the amount for the canceled meals/ persons based on the payment. After May 22, 2026 no money for any cancellations can be reimbursed. Considering the doping tests during the event, the organizing committee provides specialized and reliable catering services for athletes. Participants are advised to dine at the designated dining halls arranged by the committee whenever possible.
FINAL BANQUET	The LOC will organize a Final banquet on June 29, 2026. It will take place in the evening, after the Finals. The price is USD 29 per person. Delegation members who are staying at non-official hotels will be required to purchase the farewell party ticket (USD 50 per person). The Farewell party tickets should be requested with the Meals form and paid to the LOC not later than May 6, 2026. Cancellations or modifications of the Farewell party tickets/ number of people are accepted by May 22, 2026. The LOC will reimburse 100% of the amount for the canceled Farewell party tickets/ persons based on the payment. After May 22, 2026 no money for any cancellations can be reimbursed.
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members (see exception herein below). The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by April 22, 2026.
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	During the competition, shuttle bus services between the hotel and the venue are free of charge. Arrival and departure –Nanchang: The LOC may provide transportation to all delegation members, who have booked their accommodation through the LOC, from and to KHN airport, Nanchang railway station or Nanchang West railway station or Nanchang East railway station to the official hotel in Nanchang and back on the official arrival (June 25, 2026) and departure days (June 30, 2026). Transportation will be provided only on the official arrival (June 25) and departure (June 30) dates and will be free.

	This transportation should be requested with the official Travel form sent to the OC and LOC not later than May 6 , 2026. For those delegations or member of delegations that do not arrive or depart on the official day, upon request, the LOC may arrange additional transportation. The cost for it depends on the number of people, the date and time. Please, send your request to the OC and LOC as soon as possible but not later than May 6 ,2026 in order to be able to arrange transportation and inform you about the price.
VISA	Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Chinese Embassy or Consulate in your country/region/region if a visa is required for your travel to April 22 ,2026. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before April 22 ,2026 to the LOC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the LOC and the WG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation and the like. The WG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. Please also refer to https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php for additional information regarding the WG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges. The LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegation and must last for the delegations' entire stay. Delegation members with insufficient insurance coverage must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance coverage at the Federations own charge as follows: USD 22 per person/day, USD 32 per person/ 6 days.
ACCREDITATION	The accreditation will be held at the official hotel. The Heads of Delegation must present the followings: - Passports of all the members of the delegation - Release / Music (if not submitted in advance) - Release / Injury & Portrait (if not submitted in advance) In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.
MUSIC	The LOC is responsible to comply with the local laws of music copyright, to obtain the broadcast and online rights, and to secure and retain all clearances required with respect to any and all music or sounds displayed during any phase of the event. The ClickNClear system will be used at all World Cups 2025 to upload the music of all unit(s), to inform on the music data, and to assist the National Federations (NFs) to ensure that the music is appropriately licensed for use in competition. While the Appendix 1 of these Directives (i.e., the ClickNClear "How To" document) will guide Federations, the procedure to be completed 10 days before the start of the competition, can be summarized as follows: • The link to access the ClickNClear platform will be sent by e-mail to the participating NFs after the closing date of the definitive registrations • NFs will be required to create an account and add their unit(s) • NFs will be asked to upload the music for their unit(s) • NFs will be able to provide a music license agreement and supporting information for each of their unit(s) • Information will be given to check whether the unit(s)' music has been properly licensed. The usual Music Form (excel) will therefore no longer be used for this event.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS	Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the FIG or the LOC may not be allowed to participate in this FIG World Cup. Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organizing Member Federation by the given deadlines mentioned in these Directives may still have the possibility to participate, but the Organizing Member Federation will not guarantee the hotel booking, meals, and local transportation. Federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organizing Member federations upon arrival will not be accredited.

CANCELLATION POLICY	Rooms with or without full board canceled until April 22, 2026 at the very latest will be subject to a cancellation fee of 0%. Rooms with or without full board canceled from April 23 until May 22, 2026 at the very latest will be subject to a cancellation fee of 80% to be paid by the Federation concerned. Rooms with or without full board canceled from May 23 until June 1, 2026 at the very latest will be subject to a cancellation fee of 0% to be paid by the Federation concerned. Rooms with or without full board canceled from June 2, 2026 until the arrival of the delegations on site or “no show” will be subject to a cancellation fee of 100% to be paid by the Federation concerned.												
TIE BREAKING RULES	In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied. If there is still a tie, the tie shall not be broken. Nevertheless, the gymnasts not qualified for the finals and with same final score will receive the same World Cup points.												
PRIZE MONEY	The Organizing Member Federation must pay a minimum prize money per medallist as follows: The Prize Money, free of any deductible taxes, will be distributed in \$ as follows, considering the currency exchange rate with CHF on the day of the final, June 30, 2026. ASSIGNMENT OF WORLD CUP POINT FOR THE RANKING LIST	In principle, the results and the updated FIG World Cup Ranking List will be published on the FIG web site within 24 hours after the end of the competitions provided that all procedures before and after the competitions are duly respected by the Organizing Member Federation "Hors concours competitors" must not appear on the official results lists. Separate World Cup Ranking Lists are established for every category beginning with the first World Cup event of the year and ending with the last World Cup event of the year as follows: Men Individual Women Individual Mixed Pairs Trio Groups No World Cup points for AD and AS For Individual competitors, World Cup Points are assigned to the competitor by name. Mixed Pairs are listed by name, but considered as an entity. In case of change of partner, the Mixed Pair is considered as a new Pair. Trios are listed by name, but considered as an entity. One change of name in a Trio is allowed, but in case of a second change of name, the Trio is considered as a new Trio. Groups are listed by Federation. The World Cup Points are assigned to the Federation. If more than one Group per Federation starts at an event, only the better result will be considered. “Wild Card Participants” will not receive any World Cup Points.

“Hors concours competitors” will not receive World Cup Points.

WINNER OF THE ANNUAL WORLD CUP

The winner of the annual World Cup per category is the individual gymnast / pair / trio / group with the highest number of points of the World Cup Series Ranking List after the last event of the year:

In case of a tie at any place in the World Cup Series Ranking Lists after the last competition of the year, the tie will not be broken.

A special award ceremony will be held at the last World Cup Competition of the year in which the World Cup winner will receive the World Cup.

MEDICAL SERVICES

During all days –official trainings and competition, official medical persons who will be in the training and competition venue will be provided by the LOC.

OFFICIAL HOSPITAL

When an accident occurs, the LOC makes a phone to an “emergency medical-care center” and ask which hospital can accept the injured person depending on the gravity and the incident occurred. Once the emergency medical-care center advised the LOC of the proper hospital able to treat the injured person, the ambulance will direct him/her to this center for proper medical care.

ANTI-DOPING

Doping controls

Doping controls will be organised by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of the FIG and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.

Host federation WADC compliance

The exploitation of any rights related to the hosting of an event is subject, at all times, to the compliance with the WADC and the international standards enacted by WADA. Regardless of whether the event has already been allocated or not, the FIG may terminate any collaboration with the host federation or the LOC, immediately and without paying any penalty and/or compensation or incurring liability of any kind, under the following circumstances:

- (i) if the National Anti-Doping Organisation (NADO) in charge in the concerned country is declared non-compliant by WADA
- (ii) if the relevant country has been ruled ineligible to host the event.

	In such cases, the FIG is entitled to reassign the event to any other host federation in another country where the WADC and the WADA international standards are fully respected.		
SAFEGUARDING	From the official event day of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the possibility to contact by phone or e-mail the LOC Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment and abuse of any type or if they are worried and do not feel comfortable. The information regarding the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be communicated upon arrival of the delegations on site.
