**Pamplona (ESP)  
= AER Judges' draw / selection =**

The selected CJP, D and reserve judges will be drawn / selected for the World Championships and the Junior World Championships & World Youth Competitions except for the D Judges at the Junior World Championships & World Youth Competitions.

**Rules:**

<b>CJP</b>	2 (1 per panel)	Draw from Cat. 1 Judges (T.R Art 7.10.3 f))	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Draw in FIG office (AER TC meeting 26 February 2026)</li> <li>▪ No more than one NF represented as CJP.</li> </ul>
<b>DIF</b>	4 (2 panels and 2 per panels)	Draw from Cat. 1 and 2 (T.R Art 7.10.3 f)) with priority for Cat.1  <b>Note:</b> For the JWCH/WYC, the draw for the D judges will not be made 6 months before the event but from the judges present at the first judges' instruction at the JWCH/WYC and according to the following principles: - Art 4 of the AER Specific Judges Rules.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Draw in FIG office (AER TC meeting 26 February 2026)</li> <li>▪ Priority goes to the Federation not drawn as CJP.</li> <li>▪ Max 1 per NF in both panels</li> <li>▪ Cannot be same nationality as CJP and D in both panels.</li> <li>▪ Drawn D-judges will remain in the position for entire WCH event.</li> </ul>

Principle for all nominations, draws:

- No Presidents or Secretary Generals will be selected in any judging position.
- No sanctions and/or warnings in the previous and current cycle or pending cases.

### Draw/Nominations Procedure:

**The draw /selection begins by the Chair of Judges Panel (2), followed by the Difficulty Judges (draw by National Federation) (4) and the reserves for CJP and D.**

#### **Chair Judges**

1. 2 CJP from all Cat. 1 judge.
- 1.1. Draw from all Cat. 1 judge, draw made by National Federation (art 4 AER Specific Judges Rules).
- 1.2. The order of the draw is:
  - a) Jury A CJP
  - b) Jury B CJP

#### **Difficulty Judges**

1. 4 D Judges Cat 1. and Cat. 2, with priority for Cat.1
  - Draw by National Federation
  - Priority goes to the Federation not drawn as CJP
- 1.1. All D judges must come from a different NF, including the reserves.
- 1.2. The order of the draw is:
  - a) Jury A D 1
  - b) Jury B D 1
  - c) Jury A D 2
  - d) Jury B D 2

#### **RESERVE FOR CJP and DIF**

- a) Reserve 1
- b) Reserve 2
- c) Reserve 3

In case reserve judge need to step in, consideration will be made in order not to have the same nationality within the same panel.

#### **Note are in the Directives for the WCH and JWCH/WYC**

- If a NF rejects the draw/nomination as CJP, D Judge, this judge may not be selected to any other judging position for the same competition
- The draw for the E and A judges will be made at the judges' instruction at the WCH. No E or A judge from the same NF may be drawn in a panel where his / her NF is already represented with a CJP, D judge. He / she will move directly to the other panel
- Judges shall recuse themselves if:
  - they are or were married to or live in a registered partnership or co-habit with a gymnast
  - they are related to a gymnast by birth or marriage in direct or in collateral line, including the following persons: grandparent, parent, uncle, aunt, brother, sister, child, grandchild, nephew and cousin.
