**COMPETITION
FORMAT**

According to FIG Technical Regulations 2026, the 2026 Asian Championship is a qualifying event for the 2026 World Championships. For details, please refer to the Section 2, Art.5.1.1 Qualifications Pathway to the World Championships from the document mentioned above.

Format

The competitions will be conducted according to FIG’s Technical Regulations 2026 including Section 2 for Artistic Gymnastics, Reg. 5.1, with the following modifications.

The competition consists of Qualifications, Team Ranking, All-Around Ranking and Apparatus Finals, of optional exercises on six apparatus.

Qualifications will also serve as the qualifications for the Apparatus Finals. Team and All-Around Ranking results will be determined by results of Qualifications.

All the NF’s in good standing are entitled to participate either with a team of 3- 5 gymnasts (and 1 reserve) or with a maximum of 3 Individual gymnasts.

A Team shall be composed of a maximum of 5 gymnasts, 4 gymnasts may compete on any single piece of apparatus and the 3 highest scores will be considered for the team total.

To qualify for the Vault Apparatus Finals, two vaults are necessary. The qualifying score is based on the average of the two scores.

Only the first vault will count for the Team and All-Around ranking.

The total scores of the gymnasts who perform on all the apparatus in competition, will determine the All-Around rankings (with maximum 2 gymnasts per NF’s).

Important:

For all phases of Senior: In case of ties, the tie-breaking rules as defined in the FIG TR Art.7, Section 2 will be applied.

For all phases of Junior: According to FIG TR 2026 (Article 7, Section 2), ties will remain UNBROKEN, with shared rankings unless specified for qualification purposes to the Apparatus Finals.

Apparatus Finals

The top eight (8) gymnasts on each apparatus from the Qualifications shall be qualified to participate in the Apparatus Finals (with a maximum of two (2) gymnasts per NF).

The results of the Apparatus Finals determine the Champion on each apparatus.

Award Ceremonies

Award ceremonies will be held after each competition. The gymnasts are required to attend the Awards ceremonies.

The medals will be granted to the top 3 gymnasts/teams from each competition according to the result rankings.

In team Finals/ranking, each gymnast receives the awards, including the reserve gymnast. The same award will be presented to one designated coach at the same time.
