<p>EVENT FORMAT</p>	<p>The South American Championship consists of Qualifications and Finals in all categories and age group.</p> <p>Qualification: a maximum of 4 athletes per category, per age group and per country may apply.</p> <p>Final: Eight (8) gymnasts per category and per Age Group will go to the final (Maximum 2 per country per category per Age Group).</p> <p>If the Organizing Federation has not qualified in any Age Group, it will be able to decide in which one it wishes to participate by category. (Only one per category in the Age Group you prefer). Therefore, the maximum number of participants in the final phase is 8 + 1 in one Age Group and 8 gymnasts in the other modalities. The participant with the wild card should have participated in the respective Age Group during the qualifying rounds and will be able to receive medals.</p>
<p>AWARDS</p>	<p>A Trophy will be awarded to each of the age categories (Seniors, Age Group and Junior) for the Federation that have the highest number in the sum of the 4 highest scores from 4 different categories: IM, IW, MP, TR, GR, AD and AS (for senior and Junior only). The scores from the qualifying round will be used for team awards.</p> <p>*A medal will be awarded to the first three places in each of the Categories and in each of the modalities.</p> <p>*Certificate of participation will be awarded to all competitors and officials. *No monetary prize will be given.</p>

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All participating delegations must stay exclusively at the official hotel designated by the organization. Registrations will not be accepted or accreditations will be granted to those members of the delegations who do not meet this requirement. The values established include the following services:

- Overnight at the official hotel.
- Three meals a day (breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- Internal transportation during the event.
- Transportation to and from the airport or bus terminal in Punta del Este.
- **Personal expenses are not included in the package** , such as additional hotel services (laundry, room service, phone calls, minibar, among others). Any charges generated by these services must be paid directly at the hotel prior to departure. The federations will be responsible for covering any outstanding accounts that may exist at the end of the stay.

REGISTRATION PROCESS AND ROOM ASSIGNMENT

Provisional Accommodation Reservation:

- From April 08 to May 08.
- Complete the online accommodation form, available from the beginning of the provisional nominal registration.
- Make a deposit of 50% of the total cost of the accommodation to guarantee the reservation.

Modifications and Final Confirmation:

- From May 09 to June 08.
- Make the payment of the remaining 50% of the cost of the lodging.
- Requests for changes or payments outside of this period will not be accepted.
- For complex adjustments to the assignment, please contact the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) before the final deadline.

The allocation of rooms will be made under the criterion of "first to request, first delegation to accommodate", also considering the size of the delegations and the verification of the corresponding payments.

The Local Organising Committee (LOC) establishes a single rate for companions and reserves the right to assign the type of room (single, double or triple) according to availability and operational needs, always prioritising the accommodation of the registered participating delegations. Any special requirements will need to be coordinated directly with the organization and will be subject to approval and additional costs.

Note: Minimum booking for all delegations is from the official arrival date of the delegations until the official departure.

For federations that wish to do so, they can make the payment in cash during the Event with prior authorization from the LOC.


