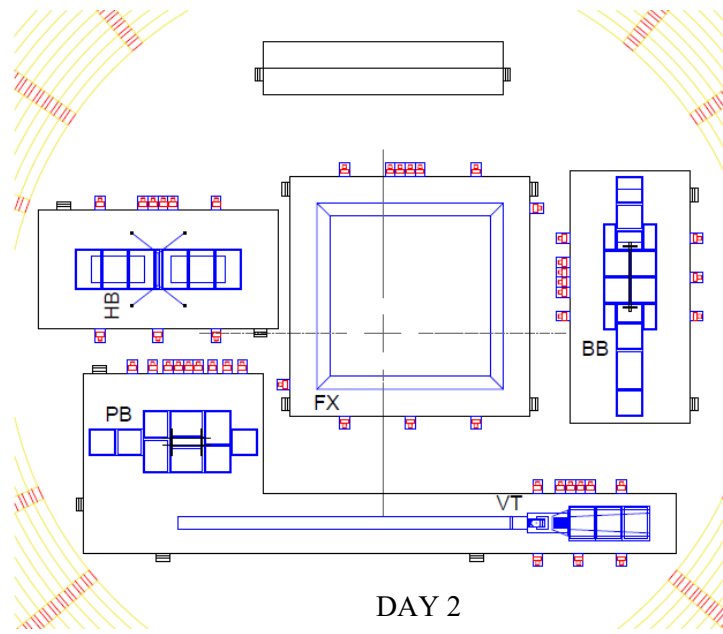
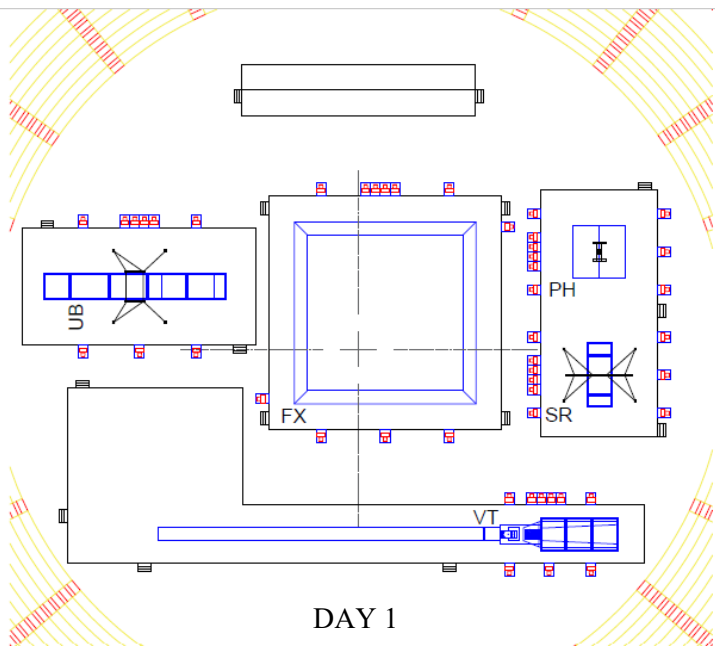

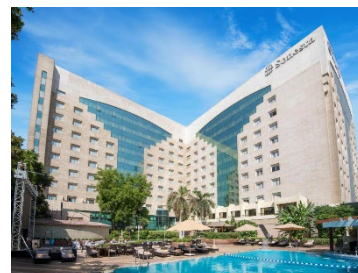

The mixed zone will be located at the exit of the FOP, between the competition hall and the training hall. This will be the meeting point between gymnasts and media.

Upon request, special appointments might be arranged between media and gymnasts, after agreed by federation concerned.

Medias are allowed to attend training in the training and competition halls. They will not interfere with gymnasts at that time.

- If after application of the tie-breaking rules as set up in the Technical Regulations, Section 2, there is still a tie, the prize money of the tied ranks will be added and divided by the number of ties
- The prize money, free of any deductible taxes, will be distributed in EUR
- The prize money will be distributed at the LOC office immediately after the medal ceremony. The athletes who win the prize must present their passport.
