Artistic Gymnastics Procedures

Nominations will be made by Commonwealth Federations to FIG Sports Manager Ms. Céline Cachemaille at ccachemaille@fig-gymnastics.org at a deadline to be defined for MAG and WAG. Priority will be given to participating Commonwealth Federations for D and E positions.

There will be a maximum of 1 ITO quota place per NF, and therefore not all NFs may be guaranteed an ITO position. It is essential that the very best judges are nominated. However, depending on the final number of ITOs nominated, an additional quota place per NF may be granted. For this reason, NFs are still required to nominate 1 D judge and 1 E judge, noting that if the nominated D judge is not selected for a D position, he or she may still be considered for an E position.

The FIG reserves the right to select neutral judges for D if sufficient quality ITOs have not been nominated by the participating federations.

Note: 1 E judge must be minimum Category 2 in order to serve as the D-jury reserve

a) Superior Jury (AS)

- Selection from FIG TC members, or, if needed, from neutral Category 1 judges proposed by the TC

b) Difficulty Judges

- Selection will be made from federation nominated Category 1 judges, ranked according to the highest examination D result from the 2024 Intercontinental Judges' Course. Following this, federation nominated Category 2 judges will be selected based on the highest examination D result from the 2024 Intercontinental Judges' Course and the 2025 International Judges' Courses. Placements will be determined by draw.

c) Execution Judges and Reserve Judges

- Selection will be made from federation nominated judges of minimum Category 3, ranked according to the highest examination E result from the 2024 Intercontinental Judges' Course and the 2025 International Judges' Courses. Placements will be determined by draw.

d) NTOs

- Selection will be made by the OC; however, NTOs must be holding an FIG International Brevet
