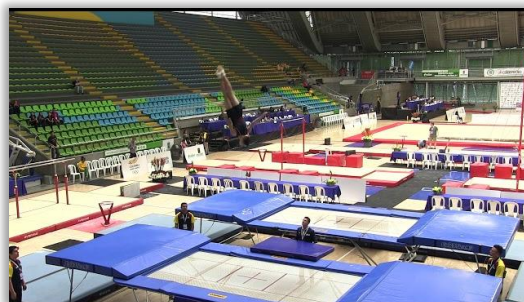

FEDERATIONS INVITED	The Pan American Gymnastics Union invites all Federations affiliated with PAGU and FIG that are up to date with their obligations.															
AGE LIMITS	<p>Senior, as per FIG Technical regulations <i>*Ages as of December 31, 2026</i></p> <p>All gymnasts must have a valid FIG license until the end of the event.</p>															
QUALIFICATION FOR OTHER EVENTS	<p>This Championship will serve as qualifier event for the following competition:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • XX Pan American Games Lima 2027 															
JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline.</p> <p>Each Federation may register a maximum of two judges for each competition in which it is registered (TRA, DMT). The fine for not registering at least one judge in the respective competition is USD\$1,000.00. Federations with a PAGU TC Member can register that Member in addition to their official judges. The fines for not registering the required number of judges must be paid to PAGU by March 23, 2026 at the latest and it does not apply to those Federations that do not have FIG brevet judges in the respective competition (TRA, DMT) and that this is the first cycle in which they participate in PAGU competitions. The National Federation must inform PAGU at the time of the definitive registration (March 23, 2026) to allow the appointment of invited neutral judges.</p>

Example: COL_FERNANDEZ_Ana_TRI_Senior_gymnast This documentation must be sent no later than April 22, 2026. In case of not sending the photograph as requested, the Local Organizing Committee can take the photograph during the registration and will have an additional cost of USD\$15.00 for each one. In case of theft or loss of accreditation, it must be informed immediately to the Local Organization Committee for the cancellation of the accreditation. The replacement of stolen or lost accreditation will cost USD\$100.00 to be covered by the accreditation holder. Accreditation will be distributed upon arrival at the registration desk. More information on the access zones for each accreditation will be given in the Work Plan. In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p>



MEDICAL SERVICES	The Local Organizing Committee will provide first aid services and ambulance at the competition and training sites during the official activities.
ANTI-DOPING	<p><u>Doping controls</u> Doping controls will be organized by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of the FIG and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and FIG Anti-Doping Rules.</p>
VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Colombian Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Medellín. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before <u>April 22, 2025</u> to the LOC (https://upag.sportevents.com.co).</p> <p>To request an invitation letter, please send the following information to the LOC: Full Name, Gender, Date of Birth, Citizenship, Passport Number, Passport Expiry Date, Function/Role within the Delegation, Arrival and Departure Dates, City where the visa application support letter should be sent.</p> <p>Please ensure that all information is complete and accurate to avoid delays in visa processing.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in the event of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation, or similar occurrences.</p> <p>In accordance with the FIG Technical Regulations, all participating Federations are responsible for ensuring that all Delegation Members have valid insurance coverage for illness, accidents, and repatriation during the entire duration of their stay.</p> <p>It is mandatory that Delegation Members are covered by basic insurance (covering sickness, accident, and repatriation) in their country of residence, in order to benefit from coverage by the FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance.</p> <p>For detailed information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges, please refer to: https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php</p> <p>The LOC will verify insurance coverage upon arrival. The policy must be valid starting from the day of arrival and must remain valid for the entire duration of the stay.</p> <p>Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance, no later than <u>April 22, 2025</u>.</p> <p>The LOC will offer insurance at the Federation's own charge as follows: USD\$150.00 per person, per day, valid for the official days of the event. INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating Federations must pay for the international travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>International Airport of arrival José Maria Córdova International Airport (MDE) The travel itinerary must be completed at SportEvents no later than <u>April 22, 2026</u>.</p>																								
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>Local transportation will be offered to and from the airport, provided that the delegations stay in one of the official hotels and book their accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee.</p> <p>The Local Organizing Committee will provide local transportation from the airport to the hotel and vice versa, only on the official arrival day, <u>Tuesday, May 19</u>, and the official departure day, <u>Monday, May 25</u> (except for PAGU representatives arriving or departing on different days).</p> <p>Delegations arriving or departing on non-official days may request transportation to their accommodations (official hotels) or to the airport on non-official days through SportEvents at a cost of <u>USD\$40.00</u> per person per trip (airport-hotel or hotel-airport). The request must be submitted and paid no later than <u>April 22, 2026</u>.</p> <p>The Local Organizing Committee will provide transportation from the official hotels to the competition and training facilities and vice versa, for all members of the delegation duly accredited and according to the official program of activities, provided that the delegation stays in one of the official hotels and books its accommodation through the Local Organizing Committee.</p>
