VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the French Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to France. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before September 2nd to the LOC.</p> <p>To request an invitation letter, please send the following information to the LOC:</p> <p>Full Name, Gender, Date of Birth, Citizenship, Passport Number, Passport Expiry Date, Function/Role within the Delegation, Arrival and Departure Dates, City where the visa application support letter should be sent.</p> <p>Please ensure that all information is complete and accurate to avoid delays in visa processing.</p>		

INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and World Gymnastics will not be held responsible for any liabilities in the event of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation, or similar occurrences.</p> <p>In accordance with the FIG technical regulations, all participating federations are responsible for ensuring that all delegation members have valid insurance coverage for illness, accidents, and repatriation during the entire duration of their stay.</p> <p>It is mandatory that delegation members are covered by basic insurance (covering sickness, accident, and repatriation) in their country of residence, in order to benefit from coverage by the FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance.</p> <p>For detailed information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for athletes and judges, please refer to:</p> <p>https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php</p> <p>The LOC will verify insurance coverage upon arrival. Each Delegation must present either a cover note or a photocopy of the valid insurance policy. INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations will cover all travel expenses of the members of their delegation.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by September 30th</p>
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>Local transportation facilities will be provided by the local LOC. Upon request, the LOC will pick up the delegations at the airport and a shuttle system will operate between the hotel and the gymnasium according to a schedule provided upon your arrival.</p> <p>In agreement with the above paragraph, no extra transportation reimbursement will be made for local transportation.</p>
ACCOMMODATION	<p>The accommodations fees will be covered for the 17 first delegations at the world championship Anvers 2023 (6 persons max) from Friday 30th October 2026 afternoon to Monday 2nd, November 2026 morning.</p> <p>The Accommodation Form must be returned to the LOC by September 30th at the very latest, the Hotel rooms will be allocated on a “first come, first serve” basis.</p> <p>The invited participating federations must pay for the accommodation expenses of their extra delegation staff members if any These extra costs for the accommodations must be paid to the LOC by September 30th.</p> <p>Please contact the local LOC for procedure details.</p>
