ARRIVAL INFORMATION	Official delegations booked accommodation via the LOC will be met at Islam Karimov International Airport in Tashkent transferred by special vehicles to the hotel at their place of residence during the competition.
ACCREDITATION	<p>Accreditation Center / LOC Room is located at the office of Uzbekistan Gymnastics Federation. There is no need for all delegation members to be present at the accreditation center. One/two responsible persons from the delegation possessing all the necessary information is enough to get accreditation for all its members.</p> <p>The following items will be checked/submitted by a responsible person:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passports of gymnasts and judges including all members of the delegations • Transport – Departure details • Settlement of all outstanding payments • The medical insurance for the members of the delegations • BIB numbers • WAG – Check the music downloaded to the ClicknClear Platform • National anthem • Possible submission of other forms • Submission of WhatsApp number of one responsible person
INFORMATION DISTRIBUTION	<p>No hard copies of any documents (start list, results & other relevant documents) will be available for distribution.</p> <p>All the necessary information will be communicated via WhatsApp group (mobile phone numbers of HoD/responsible person will be collected for this purpose). Information desks and boards, including transport, will also be set up at each official hotel's lobby.</p> <p>All STARTING ORDERS, intermediate RESULTS and FINAL RESULTS` BOOK will be sent ONLY via email to the National Federations` official email.</p>

ORIENTATION MEETING	<p>The Orientation Meeting will be held at Gymnastics Sport Palace at 18:15 on May 20, 2026. Please note that attendance is compulsory for every delegation with maximum 2 representatives, one being the Head of Delegation (or his representative).</p>
FORMS	<p>A responsible person from each delegation must submit the following forms to the Organizing Committee’s Office/OC representatives by the below mentioned deadlines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New Elements – at the Orientation Meeting at the latest. • Request to Change Apparatus Measurements – at accreditation • Vault Number – 60 min. prior to the start of the competition to the LOC Office at the latest. • Start List – at accreditation • Request for Accreditation Changes – if necessary, the form should be submitted to the WG and OC immediately for the WG approval. • Gymnast's Withdrawal from Apparatus Finals - at the very latest, 24 hours prior to the start of MAG and WAG Apparatus Final to the LOC Office.
JUDGES’ MEETING & SCORING SYSTEM INSTRUCTIONS	<p>Men’s Artistic Gymnastics The Judges’ Instruction and Draw will be held in the Judges` Room at 12:00 – 13:00 on May 20, 2026. Technical Scoring System Instruction for MAG judges will be held at 13:00 on May 20, 2026, after the Judges Instruction and Draw.</p> <p>Women’s Artistic Gymnastics The Judges’ Instruction and Draw will be in the Judges` Room at 13:15 – 15:30 on May 20, 2026. Technical Scoring System Instruction for WAG judges will be held at 15:30 May 20, 2026, immediately after the completion of Judges’ Meeting. The judges must respect the dress code mentioned in the Code of Points.</p>

	<p>All judges are required to take part in the judges' meetings, technical scoring system instructions in accordance with the schedule and location indicated in the present Work Plan.</p> <p>The drawing of lots of the Judges' Panels for the Qualification and Finals will be conducted by Technical Delegates both for Men's and Women's Artistic Gymnastics as scheduled (see Daily Schedule above).</p>
SCORING	<p>Scoring will be carried out by Sports around. Video Control system will be provided.</p> <p>Competition results will be available at Information Desks and will be sent to the WhatsApp Group.</p>
TRAINING	<p>The training sessions will take place at the training & warm-up hall adjacent to the Field of Play.</p>
COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>The World Challenge Cup competitions consist of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Qualifications and Apparatus Finals • Gymnasts can only compete on the apparatus they register for • In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up in the Technical Regulations, Section 2 shall be applied. <p>Qualifications:</p> <p>Participation is limited to 2 gymnasts per NF on each apparatus.</p> <p>In addition, the Organizing Member Federation is allowed to name a max. of 4 "hors concours" competitors (from the Organizing Member Federation) in Women's Artistic Gymnastics and a max. of 4 "hors concours" competitors (from the Organizing Member Federation) in Men's Artistic Gymnastics for a total of 8 "hors concours" gymnasts (i.e. while one "hors concours" gymnast can compete on more than one apparatus, not more than one "hors concours" gymnast can compete on an apparatus). They must be named at the time of the closing of the nominative registration and they cannot qualify for the Finals. They are not eligible to receive World Challenge Cup points; they must not appear on the official results lists and they will have to start first at every apparatus.</p> <p>A competitor can be registered as "Gymnast" on an apparatus and as "Hors-Concours Gymnast" on another apparatus.</p> <p>FIG Apparatus Finals rules will be applied for vault.</p> <p>Finals:</p> <p>The best eight gymnasts per apparatus from the qualifications qualify for the Finals</p> <p>Participation is limited to 2 gymnasts per NF on each apparatus.</p> <p>In addition to the 8 finalists, if the Organizing Member Federation is not represented in the Finals (men or women), it has the right of maximum 2 wild cards as follows (1 man and 1-woman gymnast only at one apparatus each). Gymnasts entering in Apparatus Final with wild card will have to start first. These "Wild Card Gymnasts" must have participated at the respective apparatus in the qualifications.</p> <p>"Wild Card Gymnasts" will receive medals and prize money.</p> <p>Wild Card Gymnasts" will receive World Challenge Cup points (if any) based on the ranking obtained during Qualifications.</p> <p>FIG Apparatus Finals rules will be applied for vault.</p>

APPARATUS FINAL	Gymnasts qualified for the Finals have to take their place in Apparatus Final unless they withdraw their place by using appropriate form attached.
AWARD CEREMONIES	<p>Award Ceremonies</p> <p>The award ceremonies will be held as per the detailed competition schedule and carried out in accordance with the WG Regulations for Award Ceremonies. Please ensure that your Federation's medalists are in time for the line-up prior to the ceremonies.</p> <p>The competitors requested to attend the award ceremonies will be as follows: Gymnasts ranked 1st to 3rd on each apparatus.</p> <p>Gymnasts will be required to wear the National track suit according to the FIG Rules. The national flags of the countries represented by the best 3 gymnasts will be hoisted and the national anthem of the country taken the 1st place will be played.</p>
PRIZE MONEY	In order to receive cash prizes, a gymnast must come to the office of the Uzbekistan Gymnastics Federation (Financial Department), at the end of the award ceremonies on May 24, 2026.
MEDICAL SERVICES & DOPING CONTROLS	<p>The LOC will provide first aid medical services.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation will provide at its own charge of 6 doping controls for Artistic Gymnastics (men 3, women 3).</p>
