<p>AGE LIMITS</p>	<p>WAG: Junior / Senior, as per FIG Regulations MAG: Junior / Senior, as per FIG Regulations</p> <p>Juniors:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The age of the MAG gymnasts in 2026 must be 15, 16, 17, or 18 years old (born, 2008, 2009, 2010 or 2011). NFs must indicate in the FIG database whether their gymnasts who are 18 years old will compete as juniors or seniors before their first competition in 2026. • The age of the WAG gymnasts in 2026 must be 14 or 15 years old (born 2011 or 2012) <p>Seniors:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Age limit for MAG: 18 years (born in 2008 or before) • Age limit for WAG: 16 years (born in 2010 or before) • Note: For MAG: NFs must declare on the FIG Database whether their 18-yearold gymnasts will compete as junior or senior prior to their first competition for the year concerned. <p>All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.</p>																														
<p>JUDGES AND JURIES</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet for their function with minimum Cat 4. • The participating member federations/clubs must send a minimum of one qualified judge if they participate with individual gymnast(s) and one team. 2 qualified judge if they participate with two or more teams. • The Organising Member Federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, LOC may invite neutral judges to fulfil the panel requirements. • In summary, all participating NFS/clubs must send at least: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ 1 team: 1 FIG brevet judge ➢ 2 or more teams: 2 FIG brevet judges per discipline. • Judges must commit to ALL sessions drawn/allocated. ENTRY FEES	<p>The Entry fee for this event will be: \$220 SGD per Individual gymnast</p> <p>At the time of the Definitive Registration (22 March 2026), 100% of the Entry Fee must be paid to the LOC.</p> <p>The entry fees should be paid by bank transfer to the account of Singapore Gymnastics.</p>	
ACCREDITATION	<p>Each member of the delegation will be issued an Accreditation Pass entitling them to access required areas.</p> <p>In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p>	
EVENT FORMAT	<p>Qualification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The competition consists of Qualifications, which will also serve as the qualifications for the Apparatus Finals. Team and All-Around Final rankings will be determined by results of Qualifications. The competition consists of optional exercises on four (WAG) and six (MAG) apparatus.. All the federations/clubs in good standing are entitled to participate with a team of 3-5 gymnasts (and 1 reserve). There is no limitation on individual athlete participation. Each team consists of 3-5 gymnasts and can have up to 4 gymnasts per apparatus, with the top 3 scores counting toward the total team score. Gymnasts competing as individuals (not in a team) will also be eligible for All-Around ranking and Apparatus Finals qualification. The total scores of the gymnasts who perform on all the apparatus in competition, will determine the All-Around rankings (with maximum 2 gymnasts per federation/club). Only the first vault will count for the Team and All-Around ranking. To qualify for the vault final and in vault final, two different vaults (may be from the same group, but with different numbers) must be performed. The final score is based on the average of the two scores. NO Bonus will be awarded for performing vaults with saltos in different directions. 	

	<p>Apparatus Finals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The top 8 gymnasts per apparatus (max 2 per federation/club) from the Qualification round compete in the Apparatus Finals. • Scores from the Qualification round are not carried over—gymnasts start fresh in this final. • The results of the finals determine the champion on each apparatus. <p>Tie-Breaking Rules: According to FIG TR 2025 (Article 7, Section 2), ties will generally remain UNBROKEN, with shared rankings unless specified for qualification purposes.</p> <p>Other Awards:</p> <p>MAG:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mr of Artistry (individual gymnast with highest artistry score from junior and senior categories) • Mr of Execution (individual gymnast with highest execution score from Junior and Senior Categories) <p>WAG:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Miss of Artistry (individual gymnast with highest artistry score from junior and senior categories) • Miss of Execution (individual gymnast with highest execution score from Junior and Senior Categories)

<p>INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION</p>	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 5 April 2026.</p>
<p>LOCAL TRANSPORTATION</p>	<p>Accredited Delegations who will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay at one of the official hotels, • Book their accommodation through the LOC and • Submit the travel schedule information for arrivals and departures by 5 April 2026 • Delegations arriving outside the scheduled arrival and departure dates will incur additional costs. However, the LOC will provide free local transportation for Federations staying in the official hotels.
