ENTRY FEES	No Entry Fee will be applied for this event.				
ACCREDITATION	All members will be accredited upon arrival.				
COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>It is mixed pairs competition.</p> <p>The competition proceeds in 3 rounds:</p> <p>The first round - <u>qualification</u>: 12 pairs take part, every gymnast performs on two pieces of apparatus.</p> <p>The second round – <u>semi-finals</u>: 8 best-ranked pairs pass to the second round. In case of a tie for 8th place, all the pairs for 8th place will participate in the second round. The starting order of the pairs will be according to the results of the first round: the couple on the 8th place shall start. In the semi-finals the gymnasts perform on one piece of apparatus which must be different from first round. The results of the first round are not carried forward to the second round - start from zero.</p> <p>The third round - <u>finals</u>: 4 best ranked pairs in the semi-finals pass to this final round. In case of a tie for 4th place the couple with the better result in the qualification round will participate in the 3rd round. If there is also a tie, the couple with the higher number of highest scores will participate in the 3rd round. The starting order will be determined by drawing of lots. In the final the female and male gymnasts perform on any of the pieces of apparatus (they can repeat any of already used piece except apparatus from the second round). The results of the previous rounds are not carried forward to the 3rd round - start from zero. The Grand Prix winner is the couple with the highest sum of scores in the third round.</p>
