FEDERATIONS INVITED	The Organizing Member Federation will invite all Member Federations in good standing, except from countries not allowed by the FIG exceptional measures.
JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event for the respective discipline.</p> <p>In case of participation of team. It is obligatory to send 2 FIG judges. In case of participation of 1 or 2 individuals, it is obligatory to send 1 FIG judge. The LOC will apply a fine 200 EUR per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC by November 7th, 2026)</p>
AGE LIMITS	<p>WAG: Junior Category (as per FIG Technical Regulations)</p> <p>All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.</p>
REGISTRATION DEADLINES	<p>Definitive registration September 18th, 2026 (entry form attached)</p> <p>Nominative registration October 19th, 2026 (entry form attached)</p>
ENTRY FEES	No Entry fees
ACCREDITATION	<p>Accreditation will be held at the competition venue. During accreditation the following will be checked as well:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - delegation members participation - proof of the cover note or photocopy of the valid insurance policy - payments (entry fees, accommodation, airport transfers) - FIG licence, passport, personal ID, etc. may be requested. <p>The Competition Cards should be handed in during the accreditation. In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.</p>
EVENT FORMAT	<p>The WAG competition will be organized on Saturday 28th as a team competition in artistic gymnastics and at the same time also as individual all-around competition of all participating gymnasts. The best 6 individual WAG gymnasts on each apparatus (max. 2 gymnasts from NF) will compete at the apparatus finals on Sunday, November 29th 2026.</p> <p>Team competition: 5 gymnasts in the team, 5 of these perform, 4 best scores count on each apparatus.</p>

VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Czech Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to the Czech Republic. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before October 19th, 2026 to the LOC.</p> <p>To request an invitation letter, please send the following information to the LOC: Full Name, Gender, Date of Birth, Citizenship, Passport Number, Passport Expiry Date, Function/Role within the Delegation, Arrival and Departure Dates, City where the visa application support letter should be sent.</p> <p>Please ensure that all information is complete and accurate to avoid delays in visa processing.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in the event of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation, or similar occurrences.</p> <p>In accordance with the FIG Technical Regulations, all participating Federations are responsible for ensuring that all Delegation Members have valid insurance coverage for illness, accidents, and repatriation during the entire duration of their stay.</p> <p>It is mandatory that Delegation Members are covered by basic insurance (covering sickness, accident, and repatriation) in their country of residence, in order to benefit from coverage by the FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance.</p> <p>For detailed information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges, please refer to:</p> <p>https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php</p> <p>The LOC will verify insurance coverage upon arrival. Each Delegation must present either a cover note or a photocopy of the valid insurance policy. The policy must be valid starting from the day of arrival and must remain valid for the entire duration of the stay.</p>
COVID-19	<p>The LOC should follow local guidelines in management of COVID-19. The LOC must facilitate COVID-19 testing for delegations when it is required to have a negative test for return to their country.</p>
SAFEGUARDING	<p>From the official day of arrival until the official day of departure, all participants — including gymnasts, coaches, judges, and other Delegation Members — will have the possibility to contact the LOC Safeguarding Officer by phone or email in case of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Harassment • Abuse of any kind • Any situation where they feel uncomfortable or unsafe <p>The contact information for the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be provided to all Delegations upon arrival on site.</p> <p>As part of the FIG’s commitment to athlete welfare and youth protection, posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics”, part of the FIG’s awareness campaign, must be clearly displayed in several key areas, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Training Halls • Warm-Up Areas • Public Zones <p>These measures are in place to ensure a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all participants throughout the event.</p>
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The LOC will organize transport of the official members of the delegations from Prague Airport, Vienna Airport, Brno Airport, Brno Bus station or Brno Railway station to the Sport Hall T.J. Sokol Brno I in Brno, that their accommodation was booked through the LOC. In case, that the time between the arrival of</p>

	<p>individuals or delegation is 1 hour or less, all will be taken together by one transport vehicle.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by October 19th, 2026.</p> <p>Price of transport from Prague Airport to Brno and back is 80 EUR per person and price of transport from Vienna Airport to Brno and back is 60 EUR per person.</p>
