JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>All judges must hold a valid FIG brevet on the date of the event.</p> <p>*1 If a country participates in the Senior or Junior event, it must register at least 1 international JUDGE with a FIG brevet for the 2025-2028 Cycle, Level 4 or higher, for each discipline in which it registers. Otherwise, the federation must pay a penalty fee of USD \$1.200 for each missing judge.</p> <p>Countries participating for the first time in the South American event at the Senior or Junior level are exempt from this requirement. The National Federation must inform CONSUGI in advance (at least at the time of the nominative registration) to allow the designation of an invited judge.</p> <p>The penalty fee must be paid in cash at the time of accreditation.</p>
REGISTRATIONS	<p>Participants must meet the minimum age required for the competition before December 31 of the current year.</p> <p>The fee for regular registration per athlete is \$ 70 USD and the late registration fee is \$90 USD. The pro forma invoice for registrations will be available after completing the provisional and definitive nominative registration on the website https://creatuevento.com</p>

FIG AND CONSUGI LICENSES

1. CONSUGI LICENSE

- Every athlete must obtain the CONSUGI license, with a cost of **USD 30.00**.
- The license fee is based on the definitive nominative registration, therefore, it is non-refundable.
- The license will be valid until December 31, 2026.
- Athletes who complete their registration within the established deadlines will receive a physical license card during the accreditation process at the event.

Payment Process

- After completing the definitive nominative registration, the federation may download the pro forma invoice from: <https://createevento.com>.
- Payment will be made exclusively in cash upon collection of accreditations at the event. Payment confirmation is essential to validate participation.

2. FIG LICENSE:

- **All coaches, gymnasts, judges and medical staff** must present a valid FIG license.

ACCREDITATION AND REGISTRATION

Required Documentation for Registration

Heads of Delegation must present the following documents during the registration process:

- Proof of valid medical coverage for all members of the delegation.
- Original Passports of each participant (for identity verification).
- National flag of the represented country

The accreditations will be delivered during the accreditation process. All participants must wear their accreditation visibly during all official event activities. The permissions associated with each type of accreditation (access to restricted areas, competition facilities, etc.) will be specified in the official Work Plan.

In case of loss or theft of Accreditation:

In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.

Tie-Breaking Rules:

The tie-breaking rules from the FIG Technical Regulations 2026, Section 4 (World Championship) will apply for each discipline.

Team All-Around Final:

(see the annex with the regulations for this competition)

Awards Ceremonies:

- **Individual:**
Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in all disciplines.
- **Teams:**
Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place to the entire team (gymnasts and coaches), and a 1st place trophy will be awarded to the winning team in each discipline.

Junior

Individual and Synchronized Trampoline:

- Qualification 1(Q1): 2 routines (routine 1 with compulsory requirements + routine 2 free)
- Final: 1 free routine
- No Qualification Competition 2 (Q2)

Compulsory requirements – Routine 1

- 10 different elements
- 9 elements with more than 270° of somersault rotation
- 1 front or back landing exercise (mark with *)
- 1 exercise from front or back landing in combination with the previous requirements (mark with *)
- 1 double somersault forward or backward with or without twist (mark with *)
- 1 element with a minimum of 540° of twist rotation and 430° of somersault rotation (mark with *)

These requirements cannot be fulfilled by combining them into a single element; they must be performed as separate elements.

In Routine 2 or the Final Routine, the maximum difficulty (DD) per element will be 2.1 points.

There will be no Qualification 2 (Q2); athletes will advance directly to the Final. Final clarification: Maximum of 8 finalists, with a maximum of 2 athletes per country. Athletes advance to the Final with a score of zero.

Synchronized Trampoline:

The regulations of the 2025–2028 Code of Points apply:

- The qualification competition consists of 2 routines (Routine 1 with JUNIOR compulsory requirements + Routine 2 free)
- The final competition consists of 1 free routine including difficulty
- Final clarification: Maximum of 8 finalists, with a maximum of 1 pair per country

In the routine, the following difficulty limit per single element applies:

DDmax
2.1 pts

This means that no element in the routine may exceed the difficulty indicated in the table. If this occurs, the element will receive the maximum DD value allowed for the age group, even if its actual DD value is higher.

Double Mini-trampoline (DMT):

The 2025-2028 Code of Points regulations apply:

- Qualification Competition: 2 free passes
- Final Competition: 2 free passes, with the possibility of repeating those from qualification (F1 and F2 are not performed).
- Final clarification: Maximum of 8 finalists, with a maximum of 2 per country
- In the passes, the following difficulty limit per single element applies:

DDmax

4.6 pts

This means that no element in the pass may exceed the difficulty indicated in the table for each category. If this occurs, the element will receive the maximum DD value allowed for the age group, even if its actual DD value is higher.

Tumbling:

The 2025-2028 Code of Points regulations apply:

- Qualification Competition 1 (Q1): 2 passes (meeting FIG requirements)
- Final Competition: One (1) free pass, without repeating elements from qualification (F1 and F2 are not performed)
- Athletes advance to the Final with a score of zero
- In the passes, the following difficulty limit per single element applies:

DDmax

4.3 pts

This means that no element in the pass may exceed the stated difficulty. If this occurs, the element will receive the maximum DD value allowed for the age group, even if its actual DD value is higher.

Individual Trampoline, Synchronized Trampoline, Double Mini-Trampoline and Tumbling:

- The top 8 gymnasts will advance to the Final, with a maximum of 2 gymnasts or 1 pair per country
- There will be no Team Competition at Junior Level by country


Tie-Breaking Rules:

The tie-breaking rules from the FIG Technical Regulations 2026, Section 4 (World Championship) will apply for each discipline.

Awards Ceremonies – All Disciplines:

- In all disciplines, medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in the Individual competition.

<p>INSURANCE</p>	<p>The Host Federation, CONSUGI and FIG will not assume any responsibility in cases of accidents, illnesses, repatriation, or similar situations affecting participants.</p> <p>In accordance with the FIG Technical Regulations, all participating Federations are responsible for ensuring that all Delegation Members have valid insurance coverage for illness, accidents, and repatriation during the entire duration of their stay. It is mandatory that Delegation Members are covered by basic insurance (covering sickness, accident, and repatriation) in their country of residence, in order to benefit from coverage by the FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance.</p> <p>For detailed information regarding the FIG IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges, please refer to:</p> <p> https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php</p> <p>Medical Coverage Verification: Upon arrival, the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) will conduct a mandatory verification of each delegation’s medical coverage. As a result, delegation members without personal insurance valid for their entire stay will not be accredited, i.e gymnasts will not be allowed to compete.</p>

<p>INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION</p>	<p>All participants Federations must cover the cost of their airfare to the city of Belo Horizonte.</p> <p>The travel form must be completed on the platform https://creatuevento.com/ by July 24, 2026.</p> <p>Airport reception: Properly identified staff from the Local Organizing (LOC) will be present at the Belo Horizonte/Confins – Tancredo Neves International Airport (CNF) to welcome all delegation members.</p> <p>Timely submission of the travel form is essential to ensure proper planning for delegation pick-ups. Any delay may affect the availability of transportation services. For this reason, it is strongly recommended to verify that all itinerary details (dates, times, airlines) are accurate to avoid complications.</p>
