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PARTICIPATION	The World Cup Competitions consist of Qualifications and Finals in all 5 categories. <u>Participation in the Qualifications:</u> • All competitors must take part in the qualifications. • In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied. <u>Participation in the Finals:</u> Finals in all 5 categories. • The top 8 units with no more than 2 per NF/per category from the qualifications qualify for the Finals. If there are less than 9 units, only 6 will proceed to the Final, with no more than 2 units per NF. • In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied. • In addition, if the Organizing Member Federation has not qualified in any category, it may nominate one participation in one category of its choice (indicated as “wild card participant”). • Maximum participation in the finals is therefore 8 (or 6) +1 units in one category and 8 (or 6) in the other four categories. • Such “Wild Card Participants” must have participated in the respective category in the qualification, and they will have to start first. • “Wild Card Participants” will receive medals and prize money, but they will not receive any World Cup Points. • If there are less than 4 units in the definitive registration in a category, no medals, prize money and World Cup points will be awarded. <u>World Cup Competitions may exceptionally be combined with other Competition provided those are clearly separated in the competition schedule.</u> Cancellation Policy • The organizing member Federation (LOC) may cancel the competition in the respective category if at the time of the definitive entry there are less than 4 units registered in a category. In case of such a cancellation, the LOC must																		

	reimburse, in full, the entry fee and payments made for accommodation. Should flights have to be cancelled due to the above, the risk is at the charge of the participating member Federations (NF).. • The participating member Federations (NF) may cancel its participation in a specific category without any penalty or payment for fees, accommodation and meals already booked, in case of less than 4 units in that category after the definitive deadlines • Procedure and deadlines for the cancellation of a category by the LOC or by the NF participation is as follows: • WGYM shall inform LOC and NF about the participation, within 5 days after the Definitive registration deadline. • LOC and NF have the possibility to cancel the event (in a specific category) respectively their participation within 5 days after information by WGYM. Such notification must be sent by e-mail or fax to WGYM. Cancellations after this deadline will not be accepted.
"HORS CONCOURS" GYMNASTS	The organizing member federation is allowed to add only for the qualifications "hors concours" competitors. These competitors are in addition to the official participants of the organizing member federation's competitors, they must be named at the time of the closing of the nominative registration and cannot qualify for the final. They will have to start first, they are not eligible to receive World Cup Points and prize money and they must not appear on the official results lists. The organizing member federation is allowed to name 1 Individual Men, 1 Individual Woman, 1 Mixed pair, 1 Trio and 1 Group as "hors concours" competitors.
FEDERATIONS INVITED	The Organising Member Federation must invite all WGYM Member Federations who have paid their annual membership fee for Acrobatics.
SIZE OF DELEGATION AND WGYM LICENCE	Online registrations will only be accepted from eligible member federations. Only senior gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid WGYM Licence at the time of registration until the end of the competitions may participate. The maximum size of each delegation is as per WGYM Rules for Accreditation.
AGE LIMITS	15 years in the year of the competition.
JUDGES AND JURIES	The number of juries (judges' panels) may be decided by organizing member federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges. For the composition of the judges' panels, please, refer to the Code of Points in force at the time of the event. For the judges' categories and eligibility, please, refer to the General Judges' rules in force at the time of the event. Not more than one judge per Federation per panel will be permitted. Priority will be given to the highest categories. Each participating federation must provide minimum one judge Cat. 1, 2 or 3*. Failure to do so, or if a participating Federation sends a judge with a Cat. 4 (instead of Cat. 1, 2 or 3) will result in a fine of CHF 2'000.- to be paid to the organizing member federation. * Member federation who have only Cat. 4 judges are allowed to send a Cat. 4 judge who may be used as Time and Line judge only. The organizing member federation is responsible that there are enough WGYM brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, the organizing member federation must propose to World Gymnastics for prior approval of the TC President, the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels. These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the organizing member federation. Such invitation must be made through the respective member federation. Should the organizing member federation fail to propose names for additional judges, World Gymnastics office in consultation with the TC President concerned will invite these judges at the cost of the organizing member federation
COACHES	No coaches will be accepted in this World Cup without a valid coach-sport profile at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. In order to be considered, the coach-sport profile (including all relevant documents) must be submitted in World

TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND EC MEMBER	The TD and EC member (if applicable) will be designated by World Gymnastics. The TD will serve as president of the Superior Jury (SJ).	
REGISTRATION DEADLINES	Provisional, definitive and nominative registrations must be made exclusively on-line via the World Gymnastics database . These registrations will only be accepted from affiliated member federations.

ENTRY FEES	The non-reimbursable cost for the entry fee is of 60 EUR per gymnast and must be paid to the LOC by March 24 th , 2027, together with the <i>Definitive Registration</i> .

The prices charged for the hotel rooms will not exceed the usual hotel rates. The accommodation must be booked by Acro Companion by **March 24th, 2027** (completely) at the very latest. The hotel rooms will be allocated on a "first come, first serve" basis.

The invited participating federations must pay for the accommodation expenses of their delegation members. The costs for the accommodations must be paid to the LOC as follows:

- » 50 % of accommodation costs until **March 27th, 2027**
- » The remaining 50% of the accommodation costs must be paid with nominative registration, until **April 28th** at the very latest.

Cancellation/Reimbursement Policy:

- » Cancellations before **March 27th, 2027** will be free of charge.
- » Cancellations until **April 28th, 2027** at the very latest will be subject to a cancellation fee of 50% of the total amount of the cancellation, to be paid by the Federation concerned.
- » Cancellations from **April 29th, 2027** until the arrival of the delegations on site or "no show" will be subject to a cancellation fee of 100%, to be paid by the Federation concerned.

MEALS

The invited participating federations must pay for the meals expenses of their delegation members.

- » Full board 45 €/day.
- » Lunch and dinner will be served in the Sports Complex.
- » Meals (lunch, dinner): buffet, suitable for athletes, vegetarian alternative, daily changing.

The meals must be booked by Acro Companion by **March 27th, 2027** at the very latest.

Breakfast is included in accommodation packages. Breakfast will be served at the hotel.

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FINAL BANQUET	The accommodations package, booked through the LOC, includes the closing party ticket for official delegation members. Banquet alone 45,00 €. Delegations not booking their accommodations through the Organizing Committee and additional visitors travelling with a delegation may purchase tickets to the <i>Final Banquet</i> for 45,00 € per person. Tickets for the Final Banquet must be purchased in advance <u>until May 15th, 2027 at the very latest</u>. Please include orders for the closing party tickets with the Definitive / Nominative Entry.
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. Transport is organized only from the following arrival points: » Stuttgart Airport (STR) » Aalen Train Station (Aalen Hbf) The travel schedule must be completed in Acro Companion until March 24th, 2027.
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	Transportation » from and to Stuttgart International Airport or » Aalen Train Station and » between hotel and competition venue is provided by the LOC to all delegations that have booked the Accommodation through the LOC. <u>Transportation from and to <i>Munich International Airport</i> is not included.</u>
VISA	Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the German Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Germany. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before April 27th, 2027 to the LOC. To request an invitation letter, please send the following information to the LOC: Full Name, Gender, Date of Birth, Citizenship, Passport Number, Passport Expiry Date, Function/Role within the Delegation, Arrival and Departure Dates, City where the visa application support letter should be sent. Please ensure that all information is complete and accurate to avoid delays in visa processing.
INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the LOC and World Gymnastics will not be held responsible for any liabilities in the event of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation, or similar occurrences. In accordance with the WGYM technical regulations, all participating Federations are responsible for ensuring that all Delegation Members have valid insurance coverage for illness, accidents, and repatriation during the entire duration of their stay. It is mandatory that Delegation Members are covered by basic insurance (covering sickness, accident, and repatriation) in their country of residence, in order to benefit from coverage by the WGYM IMSSA subsidiary insurance. For detailed information regarding the IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges, please refer to: https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php The insurance coverage must be submitted with nominative registration via Acro Companion. The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegations and must last for the delegations' entire stay. Delegation members with insufficient insurance coverage must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance coverage at the Federations own charge as follows: 40,00 € per person/day.

ACCREDITATION	Accreditation cards will be distributed at the LOC Office upon arrival of the delegations. For accreditation, each Head of Delegation is required to bring the following documents: » Passports of all members of the delegation. Accreditation card is personal for each of the delegation members. In case of a lost or stolen accreditation card the Organizing Committee must be informed immediately. A new card can be issued for a fee of 50,00 €. In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the safeguarding Officer operations plan upon accreditation.
MUSIC	The LOC is responsible to comply with the local laws of music copyright, to obtain the broadcast and online rights, and to secure and retain all clearances required with respect to any and all music or sounds displayed during any phase of the event. The ClickNClear system will be used at all World Cups 2027 to upload the music of all gymnasts and group routines, to inform on the music data, and to assist the National Federations (NFs) to ensure that the music is appropriately licensed for use in competition. While the Appendix 1 of these Directives (i.e., the ClickNClear “How To” document) will guide Federations, the procedure to be completed 10 days before the start of the competition, can be summarized as follows: • The link to access the ClickNClear platform will be sent by e-mail to the participating NFs after the closing date of the definitive registrations • NFs will be required to create an account and add their ACRO gymnasts/groups • NFs will be asked to upload the music for their ACRO gymnasts/groups • NFs will be able to provide a music license agreement and supporting information for each of their ACRO gymnasts/groups • Information will be given to check whether the ACRO gymnasts/groups’ music has been properly licensed. For technical support, contact support@clicknclear.com. During Podium training, NFs will be able to verify that the music for their gymnasts/group units is correctly played.
FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS	Member federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards World Gymnastics will not be allowed to participate in this World Cup. Member federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the LOC by the given deadlines mentioned in these directives may still have the possibility to participate, but the LOC will not guarantee the hotel booking, meals and local transportation. Member federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the organizing member federations upon arrival will not be accredited.

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TIE BREAKING RULES	In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied. After application, if there is still a tie after application of the tie breaking rules outlined in the TR Section 5 there is still a tie, the points of the equal ranks will be added and divided by the number of ties.																								
PRIZE MONEY	The organizing member federation will not be responsible for any local taxes payable in the beneficiary's residence country. The LOC will not be responsible for any local taxes payable in the beneficiary's residence country. The organising member federation must pay a minimum prize money per medallist. The Prize Money, free of any deductible taxes, will be distributed in Euros as follows: <i>Pairs and Groups</i> • Gold 400.- (swiss francs per gymnast) • Silver 300.- (swiss francs per gymnast) • Bronze 200.- (swiss francs per gymnast) Total minimum 11'700.- (Swiss Francs): In case of a tie, the prize money will be added and divided by the number of gymnasts: 1, 1, 3 (prize money for rank 1 and 2 is added and divided by 2) 1, 2, 2, (prize money for rank 2 and 3 is added and divided by 2) No prize money, medals and World Ranking Lists points will be given, if there are less than 4 participating Member Federations per category.																								

**ASSIGNMENT OF
WORLD CUP POINT
FOR THE RANKING
LIST**

In principle, the results and the updated World Cup ranking list will be published on the World Gymnastics website within 24 hours after the end of the competition provided that all procedures are duly respected.

“Hors concours competitors” must not appear on the official results lists.

Separate World Cup ranking lists are established for every category beginning with the first World Cup event of the year and ending with the last World Cup event of the year as follows:

- Men's Pairs
- Women's Pairs
- Mixed Pairs
- Women's Groups
- Men's Groups

Pairs are listed **by name**, but considered **as an entity**.

In case of change of partner, the Pair is considered as a new Pair.

Groups are listed **by name**, but considered **as an entity**.

One change of name in a Group is allowed, but in case of a second change of name, the Group is considered as a new Group.

The World Cup Points are assigned to the competitors as follows:

In the case that there are less than four (4) units in the definitive registration in a category, no World Cup Points will be given.

“Hors concours competitors” will not receive World Cup Points.

**WINNER OF THE
ANNUAL WORD CUP**

The yearly winner of the annual World Cup per category is the unit with the highest number of points of the World Cup Series ranking list after the last event of the year. In case of a tie at any place in the World Cup Series ranking lists after the last competition of the year, the tie will not be broken.

A special award ceremony will be held at the last World Cup competition of the year in which the winning individual gymnasts / groups shall receive a cup.

ANTI-DOPING	<u>Doping controls</u> Doping controls will be organised by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of World Gymnastics and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and WGYM Anti-Doping Rules. <u>Host federation WADC compliance</u> The exploitation of any rights related to the hosting of an event is subject, at all times, to the compliance with the WADC and the international standards enacted by WADA. Regardless of whether the event has already been allocated or not, World Gymnastics may terminate any collaboration with the host federation or the LOC, immediately and without paying any penalty and/or compensation or incurring liability of any kind, under the following circumstances: (i) if the National Anti-Doping Organisation (NADO) in charge in the concerned country is declared non-compliant by WADA (ii) if the relevant country has been ruled ineligible to host the event. In such cases, World Gymnastics is entitled to reassign the event to any other host federation in another country where the WADC and the WADA international standards are fully respected.
SAFEGUARDING	From the official day of arrival until the official day of departure , all participants — including gymnasts, coaches, judges, and other Delegation Members — will have the possibility to contact the LOC Safeguarding Officer by phone or email in case of: • Harassment • Abuse of any kind • Any situation where they feel uncomfortable or unsafe The contact information for the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be provided to all Delegations upon arrival on site. As part of World Gymnastics commitment to athlete welfare and youth protection, posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics” , part of World Gymnastics awareness campaign, must be clearly displayed in several key areas, including: • Training Halls • Warm-Up Areas • Public Zones These measures are in place to ensure a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all participants throughout the event.
MARKETING	WGYM Rules for advertising and publicity must be respected.

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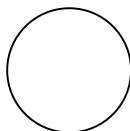
