JUDGES AND PANELS	For the composition of the MAG and WAG judges' panels, please, refer to the General Judges Rules and the Code of Points in force at the time of the event. For the judges' categories and eligibility, please, refer to the General Judges' rules in force at the time of the event. Not more than one judge per federation per panel will be permitted. The juries are set up by a draw - directed by the MAG and WAG technical delegates - from the judges present at the event. Two Judges' Panels for WAG and two or three for MAG, depending on the number of participants must be composed. Each Judges' Panel must be composed as follows: 2 D judges 5 E judges 1 Supervisor Not more than one judge per Federation per panel will be permitted (except for Time and Line Judges). The participating member federations must send minimum one qualified judge for MAG if they participate with male gymnasts and minimum one qualified judge for WAG if they participate with female gymnasts The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of CHF 2'000 per missing judge (to be paid to the LOC) should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by 20 January 2027. The organizing member federation is responsible that there are enough WGYM brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, the organizing member federation must propose to the World Gymnastics for prior approval of the TC President concerned, the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels (plus 2 reserves, 1 for MAG and 1 for WAG). These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the organizing member federation. Such invitation must be made through the respective member federation. Should the organizing member federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the World Gymnastics office in consultation with the TC President concerned will invite these judges at the cost of the organizing member federation			
WAG FX MUSIC	An online system, proposed by World Gymnastics, will be used to download the floor music of all gymnasts, to provide information on the musical data and to help the NFs ensure that all music is correctly authorized for use in competition.			

COACHES	No coaches will be accepted in this World Cup without a valid coach-sport profile at the deadline of the nominative registration. In order to be considered, the coach-sport profile (including all relevant documents) must be submitted in the World Gymnastics Coaches database at the very latest (two weeks prior to the deadline for nominative registration – step 1).																		
TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND EC MEMBER	The Technical Delegate (TD) and EC member (if appointed) will be designated by World Gymnastics. The TD will serve as Presidents of the Superior Jury.																		
REGISTRATION DEADLINES	Provisional, definitive and nominative registrations must be made exclusively on-line via the World Gymnastics database. These registrations will only be accepted from affiliated member federations. 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DRAWING OF LOTS/REPLACEMENT POLICY	The gymnasts' drawing of lots for all Apparatus World Cup events will be managed electronically. If not possible, it will take place on site, during the orientation meeting or during a separate function organized for that purpose with invitation to all participating NFs. All delegations upon arrival/accreditation must confirm the starting order. The TD's may apply adjustments to the starting order should the Draw generate organizational problems at the time of the competition. At the time of the nominative registration, the apparatus on which the gymnast will compete must be mentioned. Until accreditation, Gymnasts may be changed and apparatus can be added, as long as 2 gymnasts per apparatus per federation is respected																		
ENTRY FEES	No Entry Fee will be applied for this event for all delegation members who book their accommodation through the LOC. If accommodation is not booked through the LOC, the cost of the entry fee will be 300 EUR per delegation member. At the time of the nominative Entry (20 January 2027) 100% of the entry fee must be paid to the LOC. The entry fee is non-refundable

The organising member federation shall determine among the official hotels at its discretion, but may not chose the “low cost” category hotel.
MEALS	Hotel category I: Full board Hotels category II and III : No lunch and dinner can be provided at these hotels. There are a lot of restaurants close to the hotels.
FINAL BANQUET	The Final Banquet will be held on 28 February 2027 and will be free of charge for all delegation members who booked their accommodation through the LOC. Every delegation will receive an invitation once all financial issues between the LOC and the delegation are duly solved. The tickets for the Final Banquet will be 90 € per Person for delegations who have not booked through the LOC and must be paid to the LOC by 20 January 2027.

INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 20 January 2027
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	The local transportation from the airports Berlin (BER) and Dresden (DRS) and between the hotel and the venue will be provided at no extra cost for delegations who have booked the Tour Package Hotel. For delegation who have booked other options, the costs of 90 € (per delegation member) for the local transportation must be paid to the LOC by 20 January 2027.

INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the LOC and World Gymnastics will not be held responsible for any liabilities in the event of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation, or similar occurrences. In accordance with the WGYM technical regulations, all participating federations are responsible for ensuring that all delegation members have valid insurance coverage for illness, accidents, and repatriation during the entire duration of their stay. It is mandatory that delegation members are covered by basic insurance (covering sickness, accident, and repatriation) in their country of residence, in order to benefit from coverage by the WGYM IMSSA subsidiary insurance. ACCREDITATION	Accreditation will be distributed at one of the official hotels. In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the safeguarding Officer operations plan upon accreditation.
FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS	Member federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards World Gymnastics will not be allowed to participate in this World Cup. Member federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the LOC by the given deadlines mentioned in these directives may still have the possibility to participate, but the LOC will not guarantee the hotel booking, meals and local transportation. In case a gymnast received a DNS/DNF during the Apparatus Finals, points will be awarded based on the Qualifications ranks. If after application of the tie breaking rules outlined in the Technical Regulations, Section 2, there is still a tie, the points of the equal ranks will be added and divided by the number of ties.

Based on the Apparatus World Cup points assigned, separate men's and women's Apparatus World Cup Ranking Lists are established on each apparatus as follow:

These Ranking Lists are established after the first Apparatus World Cup event of the year and end with the last Apparatus World Cup event of the year.

WINNER OF THE ANNUAL APPARATUS WORLD CUP SERIES

The winner of the annual Apparatus World Cup Series is the gymnast with the highest number of Apparatus World Cup points on the respective apparatus after the last event of the year, taking into consideration the best results (maximum 4), regardless of the number of competitions the athletes participated in.

In case of a tie in ranks in the Apparatus World Cup Ranking List concerned, the tie will be broken by respecting the following criteria:

- The ranks of the max. four (4) counting exercises will be added and the gymnast with the lowest total prevails.
Note: in case of a tie in the ranks to determine the four counting exercises, the exercises with the highest final scores will prevail.
- If the tie remains, the final scores of the max. four (4) counting exercises will be averaged and the gymnast with the highest average prevails.
- If the tie remains, the total E-scores of the max. four (4) counting exercises (max. eight (8) scores for Vault) will be averaged and the gymnast with the highest average prevails.

	d. If the tie remains, the total D-scores of the max. four (4) counting exercises (max. eight (8) scores for Vault) will be averaged and the gymnast with the highest average prevails. Winners of the annual Apparatus World Cups Series will receive an additional prize money paid by the WGYM as per Art. 10.2. A special award ceremony must be held at the last Apparatus World Cup Competition of the year in which the winning gymnasts of the Apparatus World Cup Series shall receive a Cup.

ANTI-DOPING	<u>Doping controls</u> Doping controls will be organised by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of World Gymnastics and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and WGYM Anti-Doping Rules. <u>Host federation WADC compliance</u> The exploitation of any rights related to the hosting of an event is subject, at all times, to the compliance with the WADC and the international standards enacted by WADA. Regardless of whether the event has already been allocated or not, the WGYM may terminate any collaboration with the host federation or the LOC, immediately and without paying any penalty and/or compensation or incurring liability of any kind, under the following circumstances: (i) if the National Anti-Doping Organisation (NADO) in charge in the concerned country is declared non-compliant by WADA (ii) if the relevant country has been ruled ineligible to host the event. In such cases, World Gymnastics is entitled to reassign the event to any other host federation in another country where the WADC and the WADA international standards are fully respected.

SAFEGUARDING	From the official day of arrival until the official day of departure, all participants — including gymnasts, coaches, judges, and other Delegation Members — will have the possibility to contact the LOC Safeguarding Officer by phone or email in case of: • Harassment • Abuse of any kind • Any situation where they feel uncomfortable or unsafe The contact information for the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be provided to all Delegations upon arrival on site. As part of the WGYM's commitment to athlete welfare and youth protection, posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics”, part of the WGYM's awareness campaign, must be clearly displayed in several key areas, including: • Training Halls • Warm-Up Areas • Public Zones These measures are in place to ensure a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all participants throughout the event.
MARKETING	WGYM Rules for advertising and publicity must be respected.
TELEVISION	Television coverage will be provided. Broadcast information will be released at a later stage.
SCORING RESULT SERVICE AND VIDEO CONTROL SYSTEM	The organizing member federation must provide a scoring and result service with outputs as provided by the official scoring/data handling provider at WGYM World Championships, including a high-quality video system which allows the recording, storage and provision of compilation of the recorded images for the president of the SJ (WGYM TD). The videos with music integrated must be sent to the WGYM office within one week after the competition. During the competition, the system must be able to redisplay in real time, normal speed, slow motion or fixed image, the different sequences and the registered scores: • of one single apparatus for the Difficulty Judges' Panel of the apparatus and the Supervisor • of all gymnasts and all apparatus, even if they already performed, exclusively for the Supervisors and the Technical Delegate. The scoring and result system must include a TV graphics generator. The presentation of the TV graphics on the international signal must be identical to those used at the WGYM World Championships. Scoring information will be released at a later stage.
