PARTICIPATION	The World Cup competitions consist of qualifications and finals in all 5 categories. <u>Participation in the Qualifications:</u> All competitors must take part in the qualifications. <u>Participation in the Finals:</u> The top eight units per category from the qualifications qualify for the Finals. In addition, if the organizing member federation has not qualified in any category, it may nominate one participation in max. 1 category of its choice. Maximum participation in the finals is therefore 8+1 participants in one category and 8 in the other four categories. Such "Wild Card Participant" must have participated in the respective category in the qualification. "Wild Card Participants" will receive medals and prize money, but they will not receive any World Cup Points. If there are less than 4 units participating in a category, no medals, prize money and World Cup Points will be awarded. In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied. The organizing member federation may cancel the competition in the respective category if at the time of the definitive entry, there are less than 4 units registered in a category. In case of such a cancellation, organizing member federation must reimburse, in full, the entry fee and payments made for accommodation. Should flights have to be cancelled due to the above, the risk is at the charge of the participating member federations. <u>World Cup Competitions may exceptionally be combined with other Competition provided those are clearly separated in the competition schedule.</u> Cancellation Policy • The organizing member Federation (LOC) may cancel the competition in the respective category if at the time of the definitive entry there are less than 4 units registered in a category. In case of such a cancellation, the LOC must reimburse, in full, the entry fee and payments made for accommodation. Should flights have to be cancelled due to the above, the risk is at the charge of the participating member Federations (NF).. • The participating member Federations (NF) may cancel its participation in a specific category without any penalty or payment for fees, accommodation and meals already booked, in case of less than 4 units in that category after the definitive deadlines • Procedure and deadlines for the cancellation of a category by the LOC or participation by the NF is as follows: • WGYM shall inform LOC and NF about the participation, within 5 days after the Definitive registration deadline. • LOC and NF have the possibility to cancel the event (in a specific category) respectively their participation within 5 days after information by WGYM. Such notification must be sent by e-mail to WGYM. Cancellations after this deadline will not be accepted.
"HORS CONCOURS" GYMNASTS	The organizing member federation is allowed to add only for the qualifications "hors concours" competitors. These competitors are in addition to the official participants of the organizing member federation's competitors, they must be named at the time of the closing of the nominative registration and cannot qualify for the final. They

	will have to start first, they are not eligible to receive World Cup Points and prize money and they must not appear on the official results lists. The organizing member federation is allowed to name 1 Individual Men, 1 Individual Woman, 1 Mixed pair, 1 Trio and 1 Group as "hors concours" competitors.
FEDERATIONS INVITED	The organizing member federation must invite all member federations who have paid their annual membership fee for Aerobics.
SIZE OF DELEGATION AND WGYM LICENCE	Online registrations will only be accepted from eligible member federations. Only senior gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid WGYM Licence at the time of registration until the end of the competitions may participate. The maximum size of each delegation is as per WGYM Rules for Accreditation.
AGE LIMITS	18 years in the year of the competition.
JUDGES AND JURIES	The number of juries (judges' panels) may be decided by organizing member federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges. For the composition of the judges' panels, please, refer to the General Judges Rules and the Code of Points in force at the time of the event. For the judges' categories and eligibility, please, refer to the General Judges' rules in force at the time of the event. Not more than one judge per federation per panel will be permitted. Priority will be given to the highest categories. The juries are set up by a draw - directed by the technical delegate - from the judges present at the event. . A jury must consist of one Chair of Judges' Panel, 4 Artistic, 4 Execution and 2 Difficulty judges. A federation may not have a judge on both the execution and artistic panels. The Chair of Judges' Panel and the difficulty judges should also be from different federations. Only in exceptional situations can the Technical Delegate make the decision to deviate from this. For categories and eligibility, please refer to the General Judges Rules, Art 5 If, on the day of the competition, there are no sufficient number of judges in the requested categories, the Technical Delegate may take whatever action needed to secure the running of the event. Each participating federation must provide minimum one judge Cat. 1, 2 or 3*. Failure to do so, or if a participating federation sends a judge with a Cat. 4 (instead of Cat. 1, 2 or 3) will result in a fine of CHF 2'000.- to be paid to the organizing member federation. * Member federation who have only Cat. 4 judges are allowed to send a Cat. 4 judge who may be used as Time and Line judge only. The organizing member federation is responsible that there are enough WGYM brevetted judges present with the appropriate valid category of brevet for their function. Should there not be sufficient judges as per the on-line nominative registration, the organizing member federation must propose to the World Gymnastics for prior approval of the TC President, the name of neutral additional judges to complete the panels. These judges, once approved, have to be invited at the cost of the organizing member federation. Such invitation must be made through the respective member federation. Should the organizing member federation fail to propose names for additional judges, the World Gymnastics office in consultation with the TC President concerned will invite these judges at the cost of the organizing member federation.

	Important note for judges The judges' instruction material will be available on the STS platform in advance of the event. The publication date will be communicated to the participating federations in due time. Each judge registered to this World Cup will be required to log in to this platform by using his/her own username and password and to study the material before the official arrival day of the delegations at the very latest. This will be verified and judges who did not respect this requirement will not be allowed to judge.																		
COACHES	No coaches will be accepted in this World Cup without a valid coach-sport profile at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. In order to be considered, the coach-sport profile (including all relevant documents) must be submitted in World Gymnastics Database at the very latest (two weeks prior to the deadline for Nominative Registration).																		
TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND EC MEMBER	The TD and EC member (if applicable) will be designated by the World Gymnastics. The TD will serve as president of the Superior Jury (SJ).																		
REGISTRATION DEADLINES	Provisional, definitive and nominative registrations must be made exclusively on-line via the World Gymnastics database. 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DRAWING OF LOTS	The drawing of lots will take place at the World Gymnastics Headquarters in Lausanne (SUI) two weeks after the closing date of the nominative registration in accordance with the procedures established. Registrations made after the gymnasts' drawing of lots will not be accepted and the gymnasts will not be authorized to participate. The draw is made by names, randomly. After publication of the draw on the World Gymnastics website, the member federation will be given an opportunity to modify the position of their gymnasts'																		

	starting order within 3 days by updating their delegation information into the World Gymnastics database.
ENTRY FEES	The non-reimbursable cost for the Entry Fee is: IW/IM: 45 EUR - MP: 75 EUR - TRIO: 90 EUR - GROUP: 100 EUR
ACCOMMODATION	It is mandatory for all delegations to book their accommodation through the LOC. MEALS	The invited participating federations must pay for the meals expenses of their delegation members. Lunch – at ETPC – 26 EUR Dinner – at the Hotel of Accommodation – 26 EUR While the Meals Form must be returned to the LOC by 13, January, 2027 at the very latest. The costs for the meals must be paid to the LOC by 13, January, 2027.
FINAL BANQUET	There will be tickets for the Final Banquet available at the entry cost of 35 EUR/person.

	The tickets for the Final Banquet must be paid to the LOC until 13, January, 2027. Tickets for the Final Banquet are not refundable.
INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members. The travel schedule form must be returned to the LOC by 13, January, 2027.
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	It is mandatory for all delegations to book their local transportation through the LOC. The Organizers will arrange at a determined fee, the transport service from the LISBON International airport and OPORTO International airport to the accommodation place in Cantanhede and to the competition hall. The costs are per person. Transportation from Oporto Airport to the competition venue or hotel and back – 80€ (eighty Euros). Transportation from Lisbon Airport to the competition venue or hotel and back – 100€ (hundred Euros). The LOC only ensures the Local Transportation between the hotels and the hall of the competition to the participants who booked the accommodation by the LOC. The invited participating federations must pay for the transportation expenses of their delegation members until 13, January, 2027.
VISA	Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Portuguese Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Portugal. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before 13, January, 2027 to the LOC. To request an invitation letter, please send the following information to the LOC: Full Name, Gender, Date of Birth, Citizenship, Passport Number, Passport Expiry Date, Function/Role within the Delegation, Arrival and Departure Dates, City where the visa application support letter should be sent. Please ensure that all information is complete and accurate to avoid delays in visa processing.
INSURANCE	The Host federation, the LOC and World Gymnastics will not be held responsible for any liabilities in the event of accidents, illness (including COVID-19), repatriation, or similar occurrences. In accordance with the WGYM technical regulations, all participating federations are responsible for ensuring that all Delegation Members have valid insurance coverage for illness, accidents, and repatriation during the entire duration of their stay. It is mandatory that Delegation Members are covered by basic insurance (covering sickness, accident, and repatriation) in their country of residence, in order to benefit from coverage by the WGYM IMSSA subsidiary insurance. For detailed information regarding the WGYM IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges, please refer to: https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php The LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegations and must last for the delegations' entire stay. Delegation members with insufficient insurance coverage must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance coverage at the federations own charge as follows: 50€ (fifty euros) per person/day.
ACCREDITATION	The accreditation will take place at the Sports Hall "Os Marialvas" upon arrival to Cantanhede. The accreditations will only be handed out to the Head of Delegation. All delegations must deliver a memory stick with the music's of all routines and national anthem, flag, SPORTIVE INSURANCE declaration, passports of all members and WGYM Licenses.

	In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the gymnasts' safeguarding plan.
MUSIC	The LOC is responsible to comply with the local laws of music copyright, to obtain the broadcast and online rights, and to secure and retain all clearances required with respect to any and all music or sounds displayed during any phase of the event. The ClickNClear system will be used at all World Cups 2025 to upload the music of all unit(s), to inform on the music data, and to assist the National federations (NFs) to ensure that the music is appropriately licensed for use in competition. While the Appendix 1 of these Directives (i.e., the ClickNClear "How To" document) will guide federations, the procedure to be completed 10 days before the start of the competition, can be summarized as follows: • The link to access the ClickNClear platform will be sent by e-mail to the participating NFs after the closing date of the definitive registrations • NFs will be required to create an account and add their unit(s) • NFs will be asked to upload the music for their unit(s) • NFs will be able to provide a music license agreement and supporting information for each of their unit(s) • Information will be given to check whether the unit(s)' music has been properly licensed. The usual Music Form (excel) will therefore no longer be used for this event. For technical support, contact support@clicknclear.com. During Podium training, NFs will be able to verify that the music for their gymnasts/group units is correctly played.
FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS	Member federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards World Gymnastics will not be allowed to participate in this World Cup. Member federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the LOC by the given deadlines mentioned in these directives may still have the possibility to participate, but the LOC will not guarantee the hotel booking, meals and local transportation. Member federations which have not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the organizing member federations upon arrival will not be accredited.

CANCELLATION POLICY	50% of Accommodation cost shall be reimbursed if the cancellation occurs up to 1 month (February 17, 23:59 GMT) prior to the event. After, no reimbursement will be made. 50% of meals cost shall be reimbursed if the cancellation occurs up to 1 month (February 17, 23:59 GMT) prior to the event. After no reimbursement will be made. World Gymnastics and the LOC strongly recommend that each Member federation takes cancellation insurance for their accommodation and meals booking.

TIE BREAKING RULES	In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied. After application, if there is still a tie, the tie shall not be broken. Nevertheless, the gymnasts not qualified for the finals and with same final score will receive the same World Cup points.																							
PRIZE MONEY	The organizing member federation must pay a minimum prize money per medallist (free of any deductible taxes) as follows: The LOC will not be responsible for any local taxes payable in the beneficiary's residence country. 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ASSIGNMENT OF WORLD CUP POINT FOR THE RANKING LIST	In principle, the results and the updated World Cup ranking list will be published on the World Gymnastics web site within 24 hours after the end of the competitions provided that all procedures before and after the competitions are duly respected by the organizing member federation. "Hors concours competitors" must not appear on the official results lists. Separate World Cup ranking lists are established for every category beginning with the first World Cup event of the year and ending with the last World Cup event of the year as follows: • Men Individual • Women Individual • Mixed Pairs • Trio • Groups No World Cup points for AD and AS For Individual competitors, World Cup Points are assigned to the competitor by name. Mixed Pairs are listed by name, but considered as an entity. In case of change of partner, the Mixed Pair is considered as a new Pair. Trios are listed by name, but considered as an entity.																							

One change of name in a Trio is allowed, but in case of a second change of name, the Trio is considered as a new Trio.

Groups are listed **by federation**. The World Cup Points are assigned to the federation.

If more than one Group per federation starts at an event, only the better result will be considered.

The World Cup Points are assigned to the competitors as follows:

Finals: ranking from 1st to 8th place
Qualifications: ranking from 9th to 16th place

The units with same final score will receive the same World Cup points.

If there are less than four (4) units participating in a category no World Cup points will be awarded.

“Wild Card Participants” will not receive any World Cup Points.

“Hors concours competitors” will not receive World Cup Points.

WINNER OF THE ANNUAL WORLD CUP

The yearly winner of the annual World Cup per category is the individual gymnast / pair / trio / group with the highest number of points of the World Cup Series ranking list after the last event of the year:

In case of a tie at any place in the World Cup Series ranking lists after the last competition of the year, the tie will not be broken.

A special award ceremony will be held at the last World Cup competition of the year in which the winning individual gymnasts / groups shall receive a cup.

ANTI-DOPING	<u>Doping controls</u> Doping controls will be organised by the International Testing Agency (ITA) on behalf of World Gymnastics and according to the World Anti-Doping Code (WADC), the international standards enacted by the World Anti-doping Agency (WADA) and WGYM Anti-Doping Rules. <u>Host federation WADC compliance</u> The exploitation of any rights related to the hosting of an event is subject, at all times, to the compliance with the WADC and the international standards enacted by WADA. Regardless of whether the event has already been allocated or not, World Gymnastics may terminate any collaboration with the host federation or the LOC, immediately and without paying any penalty and/or compensation or incurring liability of any kind, under the following circumstances: (i) if the National Anti-Doping Organisation (NADO) in charge in the concerned country is declared non-compliant by WADA (ii) if the relevant country has been ruled ineligible to host the event. In such cases, World Gymnastics is entitled to reassign the event to any other host federation in another country where the WADC and the WADA international standards are fully respected.
SAFEGUARDING	From the official day of arrival until the official day of departure, all participants — including gymnasts, coaches, judges, and other Delegation Members — will have the possibility to contact the LOC Safeguarding Officer by phone or email in case of: • Harassment • Abuse of any kind • Any situation where they feel uncomfortable or unsafe The contact information for the LOC Safeguarding Officer will be provided to all Delegations upon arrival on site. As part of the WGYM's commitment to athlete welfare and youth protection, posters of the “10 Golden Rules of Gymnastics”, part of the WGYM's awareness campaign, must be clearly displayed in several key areas, including: • Training Halls • Warm-Up Areas • Public Zones These measures are in place to ensure a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all participants throughout the event.
MARKETING	WGYM Rules for advertising and publicity must be respected.

The videos with music integrated must be sent to the WGYM Offices within one week after the competition. Throughout the competition, the system must be able to redisplay in real time, normal speed, slow motion or fixed image, the different sequences and the registered scores of every exercise performed for the president of the SJ. The scoring and result system must include a TV graphics generator. The presentation of the TV graphics on the international signal must be identical to those used at the WGYM World Championships.
