### Judges: judges must have a current valid FIG brevet

**\*Note:** NF's can participate with 1 additional gymnast (reserve) in case the NF is competing with group. The reserve gymnast shall train with the group during the training time of his/her Federation including podium training.

**Note:** TC members can be registered additionally to the 2 judges composing the official Delegation.

**Note:** Federations who don't bring a minimum of 1 judge will have to pay a fine of USD 1000,00 to cover the costs of an invited judge. The NF will have to inform PAGU before the Deadline for nominative registration.

## Credentials

---

Federations shall send 1 photo for each member of the official Delegation for the credential until Feb. 20, 2014. The photos shall have the following specifications:

- ❖ Good resolution,
- ❖ .jpeg or .jpg format;
- ❖ Size: 190 X 250 pixels;
- ❖ File size: Approximately 50kb.

Federations who don't send the photos by the Deadline will have to pay USD 5,00 for having them taken in the accreditation upon arrival.

## Qualification for Youth Olympic Games

WAG Gymnasts born in 1999 and 16-17 years-old MAG gymnasts born between Jan. 01 1997 and Dec. 31 1998 will be eligible for qualifying his/her NF for Youth Olympic Games 2014. Gymnasts who have competed in FIG Seniors competitions or multigame events (Including Continental Championships and World Cups) will not be eligible for the YOG.

The 9 places for WAG (including the possible places for "Universality") and 8 for MAG (1 per country) will be distributed per continent for the Youth Olympic Games 2014 according to the AA classification in this Junior Pan-American Championships. The places will be distributed to each qualified NF according to each eligible gymnast AA qualifications (15 years-old Gymnasts (WAG) and 16-17 years-old gymnasts (MAG)), being clear that the places are not nominal. However, the gymnasts who use this place destined to the NF do not have necessarily to have participated in this Juvenile Pan-American Championships.



There are 06 places (03 WAG and 03 MAG) that will be distributed according to the Universality of National Olympic Committees' (NOC) criteria, the same that define the International Olympic Committee according to the balance of participation of the continents. These places are not additional to the maximum number for the American Continent (09 WAG and 08 MAG). There is a maximum of 1 gymnast per NF and it will be nominative according to the results of the Junior Pan-American Championships 2014. Gymnasts who look for a place for Universality of NOC shall participate in the AA in the Junior Pan-American Championships and obtain a minimum standard that will be defined by FIG. About 30% of the total places for gymnasts in the Youth Olympic Games will be from NOC Universality.

YOG qualification will be based upon FIG junior rules

### **FIG Licences**

According to the article 5.1 of the Technical Rules of FIG, it is necessary in every juvenile and senior competitions that the gymnasts have a valid FIG licence.
