GYMNASTS' DRAWING OF LOTS PROCEDURES

We are pleased to hereby submit the procedures for the RG Individual and Groups' drawing of lots for the 35th FIG Rhythmic Gymnastics World Championship in Pesaro (ITA).

General principle for Individual competitions and Group competitions:

The order of the Apparatus for Individuals and Groups are pre-defined.

- Random draws are carried out by computer for all phases of competitions.
- Draws are conducted in the following order of priority:
 1. Individual Qualification
 2. Individual All-Around Final
 3. Individual Apparatus Finals
 4. Group General Competition
 5. Group Final (one type and 2 types of apparatus)

Individual Competitions – Qualifications (98 Individuals)

Once all 98 positions are filled, the starting order is divided into seven (7) sub-groups of 14 Gymnasts each (sub-groups A to G). Sub-group A start the competition followed by sub-groups B, C, D, E, F and G.

1st day of qualification:

Gymnast 1-14 from sub-group A compete alternately on Hoop and Ball then immediately on Ball and Hoop.

Same principle for sub-groups B to G.

2nd day of qualification:

Gymnast 8-14 followed by gymnasts 1-7 from sub-group A compete alternately on Clubs and Ribbon then immediately on Ribbon and Clubs.

Same principle for sub-groups B to G.

Individuals Competitions – All-Around Final

In order to establish the Working order on the All-Around Final two (2) draws are carried out as follows:

1st rotation – Individual gymnasts ranked 13-24 of the Qualifications

- To fulfill the starting order 1-12 of the 1st rotation of the All-Around, a random draw is carried out with the Individual gymnasts ranked 13-24 of the Qualifications

2nd rotation – Individual gymnasts ranked 1-12 of the Qualifications

- To fulfill the starting order 1-12 of the 2nd rotation of the All-Around, a random draw is carried out with the Individual gymnasts ranked 1-12 of the Qualifications.

Individuals - Apparatus Finals

In order to establish the Working order on each apparatus final, four (4) different draws are carried out until the positions 1-8 are filled.

Group Competitions – General Competition (30 Groups)

Once all 30 Groups have been drawn, the starting order is divided into two (2) sub-groups (A and B) of 15 Groups each.

Groups 1-15 from sub-group A start the competition and compete alternately on the exercise using one type of apparatus and on the exercise using two types of apparatus, then immediately on exercise using two types of apparatus and on the exercise using two types of apparatus
Same principle for sub-group B.

Group Finals - Finals for the exercise using one and two types of apparatus

In order to establish the Working order on each type of apparatus, two (2) different draws are carried out until the positions 1-8 are filled.
