Make sure that your gymnasts use only FIG certified Hand Apparatus for this event and for any other FIG recognized competitions, as they will not be allowed to compete with an Apparatus which does not comply with the norms. AGE LIMITS	<p>RGI and RGG: Senior: 16 All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event.</p>									
JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline (RGI and/or RGG)</p> <p>Each Federation can register up to 2 judges (up to 1 for Individual competition and up to 2 for Groups) The fine for not registering at least one judge for each competition in which the federation is registered will be of USD\$1,000.00 per each (Individual and Groups). The fine must be pay to the Local Organizing Committee at last on April 30th, 2019 and doesn't apply to the Federations that doesn't have FIG Brevet Judges in the respective competition. The national federation must inform the Local Organizing Committee with antelation (at the definitive registration), to allow the designation of an invited neutral judge.</p>
