FEDERATIONS INVITED	<p>The Organizing Member Federation will invite all AGU Member Federations in good standing. Federations which have not fulfilled their annual membership fees towards the AGU, the FIG and not fulfilled their financial obligations towards the Organising Committee will not be allowed to participate in the Asian Championships.</p>	
AGE LIMITS	<p>* Age limit for Senior MAG: 18 years (born in 2001 or before) * Age limit for Senior WAG: 16 years (born in 2003 or before)</p>	
FIG LICENSE	<p>All gymnasts must present a valid FIG License until the end of the event, in order to be eligible to participate in an international competition.</p>	
ENTRY FEES	<p>No Entry Fee will be applied for this event.</p>	
MEDICAL SERVICES	<p>The Local Organizing Committee will provide first aid medical services.</p>	
ACCREDITATION	<p>The accreditation will take place upon arrival of the delegations. Together with the nominative registration, the delegations must send to the LOC a passport photo of each delegation member(in electronic format). COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>The competitions will be conducted according to FIG's <i>Technical Regulations 2019</i> including Section 2 for Artistic Gymnastics, Reg. 5.1, with the following modifications for Senior.</p> <p>The competition consists of Men's and Women's Team Finals, All-Around Finals and Apparatus Qualifications and Finals.</p>	

Team Final, All-Around Final, Apparatus Qualifications
Competition Day 1: MAG, Competition Day 2: WAG

Team and All-Around Final will also serve as the qualifications for the Apparatus Finals.

All the federations in good standing are entitled to participate either with a team of 4 - 5 gymnasts or with a maximum of 3 Individual gymnasts.

Member Federations with 3 individuals may be considered in the team ranking in the Qualification and may be in the ranking list for the Team Final provided they register as a team at the provisional and definitive entry registration deadline.

A Team shall be composed of a maximum of 5 gymnasts, 4 may compete on any single piece of apparatus and the 3 highest scores will be taken into account for the team total.

For men, the competition consists of optional exercises on six apparatus.

For women, the competition consists of optional exercises on four apparatus.

To qualify for the vault finals, two vaults are necessary. The qualifying score is based on the average of the two scores.

Only the first vault will count for the Team and All-Around ranking.

The total scores of the gymnasts, who perform on all the apparatus in competition, will determine the All-Around rankings (with maximum 2 gymnasts per federation).

The tie-breaking rules will be applied for the Team Final as defined in the FIG Technical Regulations according to the Art. 4.4.2.3 and All-Around Final according to the Art. 4.4.2.1.

In the qualifications for the Apparatus Finals, in case of ties, the tie-breaking rules as defined in the FIG TR according to art: 4.4.1.2

Apparatus Finals

The results of the finals determine the champion on each apparatus.

The top eight gymnasts on each apparatus from the Apparatus Qualifications shall be qualified to participate in the Apparatus Finals (with maximum 2 gymnasts per Federation).

In case of ties, the tie-breaking rules as defined in the FIG TR according to the Art. 4.4.2.2

*Award Ceremonies

Award ceremonies will be held after each competition. These gymnasts are required to attend the Awards ceremonies.

The medals will be granted to the top 3 gymnasts/teams from each competition according to the result rankings.

Tied gymnasts /teams will receive the same colored medal.

INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.</p> <p>The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federation own charge as follows: 30 USD per person/day.</p>
