GYMNASTS' DRAWING OF LOTS PROCEDURES

We are pleased to provide you with the procedures for the drawing of lots of the Individuals and Groups for the 1st FIG Rhythmic Gymnastics Junior World Championship in Moscow (RUS).

General principles for Individual and for Group competitions:

The order of the apparatus for Individuals and Groups are pre-defined, Rope/Ball, Clubs/Ribbon for RGI and 5 Ribbons, 5 Hoops for RGG.

- Random drawing of lots will be carried out by computer for Qualifications and Apparatus Finals
- Drawing of lots will be conducted in the following order of priority:
 1. Individual Qualification
 2. Individual Apparatus Finals
 3. Group General Competition
 4. Group Finals

Individual Competitions – Qualifications (62 Federations)

General principles:

- 1) One drawing of lots will be conducted with all Federations.
- 2) The order from 1) will be divided into four (4) groups (A, B, C and D).
- 3) Groups A and B will be composed of 15 Federations, groups C and D of 16 Federations.
- 4) Federations will be allocated alternately on Rope (Federation drawn 1) and Ball (Federation drawn 2), etc.
- 5) Group A will start the competition followed by groups B, C, and D.

Day 1:

Group A starts with gymnasts from Federations drawn 1 to 15 who will compete alternately on Rope and Ball, then rotate to compete on their second apparatus, respectively Ball and Rope. Same principle for groups B, C (gymnasts 1 to 16) and D (gymnasts 1 to 16).

Day 2:

The Federations remain in their respective groups (A, B, C or D) but the starting order within each group will be determined by a new drawing of lots. Group A starts with gymnasts from Federations drawn 1 to 15 who compete alternately on Clubs and Ribbon, and rotate to compete on their fourth apparatus, respectively Ribbon and Clubs. Same principle for groups B, C (gymnasts 1 to 16) and D (gymnasts 1 to 16).

Individuals - Apparatus Finals

The starting order for each Apparatus Final will be determined by four (4) different drawing of lots.

Group Competitions – General Competition (33 Federations)

General principles:

- 1) One drawing of lots will be conducted with all Federations.
- 2) Federations will be allocated alternately on 5 Hoops (Federation drawn 1) and 5 Ribbons (Federation drawn 2), etc.
- 3) Each Group will perform one routine per day.

Day 1:

The group will compete in the order of the drawing of lots.

Day 2:

To determine the starting order of 5 Hoops, a new drawing of lots will be conducted within the Federations having already performed 5 Ribbons.

To determine the starting order of 5 Ribbons, a new drawing of lots will be conducted within the Federations having already performed 5 Hoops.

Group Apparatus Finals

The starting order for each Apparatus Final will be determined by two (2) different drawing of lots.
