**PARTICIPATION**

The World Cup competition will consist of Qualifications and Finals.

**Participation in the Qualifications:**

- All competitors must take part in the qualifications.
- No qualifications must be held if there are less than 9 participants per disciplines.
- In case of a tie at any place, the tie-breaking rules as set up for the World Championships shall be applied. Nevertheless, the gymnasts not qualified for the finals and with the same final score will receive the same world cup points.

**Participation in the Finals:**

- The top eight gymnasts or pairs from the qualifications qualify for the finals.
- Max. 2 individuals or 1 pair per NF per discipline.

**Cancellation Policy** (valid for Tumbling and Double Mini-Trampoline only):

- The **organizing member Federation (LOC)** may cancel the competition in the category TUM and/or DMT if at the time of the definitive entry there are less than 4 countries registered in this category. In case of such a cancellation, the LOC must reimburse, in full, the entry fee and payments made for accommodation. Should flights have to be cancelled due to the above, the risk is at the charge of the participating member Federations (NF).
- The **participating member Federation (NF)** may cancel its participation in men's or women's TUM and/or DMT without any penalty or payment for fees, accommodation and meals already booked, in case of less than 4 participating countries in that category after the definitive deadlines.
- Procedure and deadlines for the cancellation of the TUM and/or DMT competitions by the organizing member federation or participation by the NF is as follows:
- FIG shall inform the organizing member federation about the participation, within 5 days after the Definitive registration deadline.

	<p>– The organizing member federation has the possibility to cancel the TUM and/or DMT event respectively their participation within 5 days after information by the FIG. Such notification must be sent by e-mail or fax to the FIG. Cancellations after this deadline will not be accepted.</p>																																																																																								
<b>“HORS CONCOURS” GYMNASTS</b>	<p>The Organizing Member Federation is allowed to add only for the qualifications “hors concours” competitors. These competitors are in addition to the official participants of the Organizing Member Federation’s competitors, they must be named before the start of the qualifications and cannot qualify for the final. They will have to start first.</p> <p>The Organizing Member Federation is allowed to name 1 Individual Men and 1 individual Women, as well as 1 Synchro pair Men and 1 Synchro pair Women as “hors concours” competitors. For Tumbling and Double Mini-Trampoline, the number of “hors concours” competitors is 2 Men and 2 Women.</p>																																																																																								
<b>FEDERATIONS INVITED</b>	<p>The Organizing Member Federation must invite all FIG Member Federations who have paid their annual membership fee for Trampoline Gymnastics.</p>																																																																																								
<b>SIZE OF DELEGATION AND FIG LICENCE</b>	<p>Only senior gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License may participate. The Organizing Committee will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnast’ Licenses. No gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the deadline of the Nominative Registration. <b>AGE LIMITS</b>	<p>Participating gymnasts must be at least 17 years (born in 2002 or before) in all disciplines.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> <i>gymnasts who have participated in a Senior World Championships, Senior Continental Championships or World Cup competitions may <u>not</u> participate in Junior competitions afterwards.</i></p>																																																																																								
<b>JUDGES AND JURIES</b>	<p>The number of Judges’ panels may be decided by the organizing member federation depending on the number of participating competitors and judges. If possible must be as follow:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two Judges’ Panels for IND and SYN</li> <li>• One Judges’ Panel for TUM and DMT</li> </ul> <p>The Judges’ panels will be set up by a draw – directed by the FIG Technical</p>																																																																																								

Delegate – from the judges present at the event.

Each participating federation must provide minimum one judge (according to FIG General Judges' Rules) per discipline in which they participate. Failure to do so will result in a fine of CHF 2'000.- per discipline, to be paid to the organizing member federation.

The organizing federation is responsible that there are enough FIG brevetted judges present with the appropriate category of brevet for their function (minimum category III).

The FIG Technical Delegate will serve as President of the Superior Jury.

In the 2019-2020 Trampoline, Tumbling and Double Mini-Trampoline World Cup Series, 3 supervisors will be nominated by FIG.

<b>DRAWING OF LOTS</b>	The drawing of lots will take place at the FIG Headquarters in Lausanne (SUI) two weeks after the closing date of the nominative registration. - 04.09.2019
<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	<p>The cost for the entry fee is <b>120 Euro</b> per gymnast.</p> <p>The invited participating federations must pay for all entry fees. At the time of the Definitive registration (till 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2019) 100% of the entry fee must be paid to the OC. The entry fee is not refundable.</p> <p>Entries without payment of the entry fees will be considered as invalid and will be refused.</p>

<b>INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>The invited participating federations must pay for the travel costs of their delegation members.</p> <p>The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by <b>21<sup>st</sup> August 2019</b>.</p>
<b>LOCAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>The local transportation (i.e. from/to the airport, railway station and/or bus station as well as from/to the hotel and the competition, training and warm-up halls) is free of charge for delegations who booked their accommodation through the LOC.</p>
<b>VISA</b>	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Russian Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to <b>Russia</b>. The Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before <b>16<sup>th</sup> August 2019</b>. The request must include the full name, date of birth, gender, function, passport number, passport expiry date, and the arrival and departure dates of the delegation member as well as the city the visa application letter must be sent to. The request should be send as Word or Excel file.</p>
<b>INSURANCE</b>	<p>The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient coverage must inform the LOC in advance. The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations' own charge as follows: <b>5 Euro per person/day</b>.</p>
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	<p>Accreditations are managed by sporttech.io system. Each Federation will receive an email from LOC with specific instructions immediately after the Definitive Entry.</p> <p>FIG Accreditation rules have to be strictly respected and applied notably as far as the number of accreditations and transferable access cards (TAC) per federation is concerned. The accreditation identifies individuals in good standing from FIG affiliated federations participating in the event. It indicates and defines individuals' right to access to the different zones as per their functions. All participants and officials are required to wear their Accreditation Card at all times.</p> <p>The accreditation is personal, non-transferable and compulsory to have access to the training and competition halls, the official functions and the transport system of the LOC (if applied). The access in the warm-up Hall is strictly limited to the gymnasts participating in the specific competition and according to the warm-up schedule, with the appropriate delegation member's transferable access card. The accreditation card is also necessary to pass the security controls and have access to lunch and dinner.</p>

**Assignment of WORLD CUP SERIES RANKING POINTS**

In principle, the official results and the updated FIG World Cup Series Ranking List will be published on the FIG web site within one working day after the competition.

Separate World Cup Series Ranking Lists are established for every discipline, beginning with the first World Cup event of the year and ending with the last World Cup event of the year as follows:

- Trampoline Individual Men
- Trampoline Individual Women
- Trampoline Synchro Men
- Trampoline Synchro Women
- Tumbling Men
- Tumbling Women
- Double Mini-Trampoline Men
- Double Mini-Trampoline Women

For individual Trampoline, Tumbling and Double Mini-Trampoline, World Cup points are assigned to the competitors by name.

Trampoline Synchro pairs are listed by name, but considered as an entity. In case of change of a Synchro partner, the Synchro Pair is considered as a new pair.
