PROHIBITED ITEMS IN THE ARENA

Appendix 7

List of the prohibited items by the Russian law in the Arena

As the following items are prohibited by law in the Arena, all bags will be checked through the metal detector.

- Glass containers and bottles
- Liquids in containers larger than 100 ml
- Thermoses and flasks
- Bulky items, the sum of three dimensions of which in length, width and height exceeds 75 cm
- Any animals
- Sports gear and sports equipment, including bicycles, rollers, skateboards and kick scooters
- Musical instruments and wind instruments for producing loud sounds (including vuvuzelas)
Exception: bugles, pipes with a sound level of up to 120 dB
- Food and beverages (including alcoholic)
Exception: baby food, baby milk and sterilized water, including in glass containers, to all the sites:
 - Soy milk for children;
 - Sterilized water or cow milk intended for children;
 - Baby food of different consistency
 - In some cases, the volume may be more than 100, l, but should not exceed 1 liter per child. Adults carrying baby food or milk may be asked to provide it for inspection
- Explosives, detonators and items containing them
- Flammable and pyrotechnic substance and items and items (chemical materials) that may be used to make pyrotechnic devices or smokes
Exception: matches, pocket lighters
- Any weapon, including self-defence, ammunition, or component parts of guns
- Piercing or bladed items, knives, cold steel weapons and any other object that may be used as a weapon
- Compressed and liquefied gases
Exception: fire extinguishers provided for the vehicle configuration in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulations, as well as for equipping of temporary structures at the Stadium in accordance with the Rules of the Fire Prevention Rules in the Russian Federation and Temporary Recommendations for Fire Prevention for FWC Sites
- Highly flammable and fuel liquids, flammable gases
- Poisonous, noxious or pungent substance
- Combustible solids
- Oxidising substances and organic peroxides
- Toxic, radioactive, caustic or corrosive materials
- Other materials, articles, object (including self-made items) that can be used to generate smoke or flames
- Devices and articles (including self-made items) other than pyrotechnics, which are used to used to spray various materials and substance ("firecrackers")

- Radio electronic means and high-frequency devices
- Television (professional video cameras and television radio set) and telecommunication equipment
- Mounts for photo and video equipment
- Materials of an extremist, offensive or discriminatory nature containing Nazi attributes or symbols or attributes similar to Nazi symbols, and/or the attributes or symbols of extremist organization, or aimed at discrimination of any kind against a country, person or group based on race, color of skin, ethnic, national or social background and wealth birth, age or other status, gender, disability, language, religion, political opinion or any other opinion, sexual orientation or on any other grounds, including but not limited to banners, flags, symbols and paraphernalia, fliers and apparel
- Flags and banners larger than 2x1,5m
- Advertising materials of any kind, printed products with religious, political or offensive content, or information that contravenes public order and/or morals (including banners, streamers, posters, signs or their equivalents)
- Equipment that may interfere with holding the Events or create an inconvenience for the participants (laser devices, light), radio station or sound amplification means
- Moving and gliding aircraft or their models (gliders, drones, kites, etc.)
- Folding chairs or benches
- Poles for flags or posters of any type
- Items with trademarks or other kinds of advertising symbols or information, demonstration of which can be used for commercial purposes
- Masks, helmets, as well as any other means of disguise or items specifically designed for concealing the persons identification
- Body protection gear: bullet-proof vests, body protection gear used in martial arts or extreme sports, or corsets
- Paper rolls or paper in reams
- Coloring substances
- Any quantities of powdery materials
- Any items that outwardly resemble any Prohibited items or are copies or equivalents thereof
- Devices used to record, transmit, stream, upload, publish on the internet or otherwise descriptions, data, Match results or statistics using any method of transmission via a computer, mobile phone, auxiliary devices for managing data, or via any media or platforms, other digital technology, networks or blog platforms, websites, application and other similar media devices, as well as any existing or future media technologies (either those currently known or which may be invented or developed in the future) if these actions are done for commercial purposes.

Any object being the subject of an offense will be confiscated
