| <b>JUDGES AND JURIES</b>      | <p>Due to shortage of qualified judges in Africa, in each discipline involved, the participating federation <b>is requested to present the <u>maximum</u> number of eligible judges</b> with a minimum of <b>Category 3</b> qualification:</p> <p><b>MAG:</b> Up to three (03) judges per federation<br/><b>WAG:</b> Up to three (03) judges per federation</p> <p>Any Category 4 judge presented by participating delegations will be used as technical assistants. The host federation may present more than 3 judges per discipline, however, any additional judges over the permitted amount will only be used as technical assistants.</p> <p><b>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline.</b></p> <p><b>Number of Members of the Judges Panels:</b><br/>MAG: 6-9 Judges per Apparatus, with additional line and time judges.<br/>WAG: 4-9 Judges per Apparatus, with additional line and time judges.</p> |
| <b>REGISTRATION DEADLINES</b> | The entry procedure is notified to the Federations concerned by the Organiser of the Games via their National Olympic Committees (COJA). After the Nominative Registration no new entries or modification will be taken into account, except in case of a duly proven illness or injury.   |
