The Apparatus control includes the check of the dimensions of the RG competition floors which must respect the valid FIG Apparatus Norms. All floors must be set up correctly and the RG competition floors in the different halls must be identical.

OLYMPIC QUALIFICATION RANKING LIST

The 2020 RG World Cup Series Ranking List for **Individual All-Around** will be qualifying for the 2020 Olympic Games.

The Olympic Qualification Ranking list will be established after the last competition of the 2020 World Cup Series. The assignment of World Cup points for each competition will be the base to establish the Olympic Qualification Ranking list. However, gymnasts who obtained a quota place for their NOC (1 or 2) at the 2019 Baku World Championships, will be deleted from the list of each competition and the number of points earned will be assigned to the next eligible gymnast.

YEARLY WINNER OF THE WORLD CUP SERIES

The yearly winner of the Rhythmic Gymnastics World Cup Series is the gymnast / group with the highest number of points of each of the World Cup Series Ranking List of the respective year, after the last event of the series, counting the best results (maximum 3 out of 4).

A special award ceremony will be held at the last World Cup Competition of the year in which the winning gymnasts/groups shall receive a Cup.
