There have been some questions regarding the calculation of the results for the FIG Virtual Parkour Competition (E-FISE). The FIG Directives for the competition state the results' calculation method. See below in blue, plus table added as an example. Any results' calculation information received from FISE during the registration process for the competition pertains to the other sports and NOT Parkour.

We hope this information clears up any misunderstandings and wish all athletes best success.

## Competition Results (from the Directives)

### **Freestyle Qualifications**

The first component of the score is evaluated by FIG judges based on the criteria defined in the Judging Criteria section (ranking is 50% of score). The second component of the score is the rank by public vote on the FISE website (ranking is 50% of score).

The final ranking list of the Qualifications (average of the FIG judges' scoring rank and the public voting rank) will be established at the end of Qualification runs.

### **Freestyle Finals**

The top eight athletes from the final ranking list of the Qualifications participate in the Finals. The Qualification scores will not be carried over to the Finals ("new life").

The first component of the score is evaluated by FIG judges based on the criteria defined in the Judging Criteria section (ranking is 50% of score). The second component of the score is the rank by public vote on the FISE website (ranking is 50% of score).

The final ranking list of the Finals (average of the FIG judges' scoring rank and the public voting rank) will be established at the end of Finals runs.

Example:

Athlete Name	Federation	Rank from Judges (50%)	Rank from Public Vote (50%)	Average Rank (100%)	Final Rank
HAMMEL	GER	1	8	4.5	1
SMITH	GBR	7	3	5	2
LIUNG	CHN	2	10	6	3

*Note: A tie for 8<sup>th</sup> in the final rank of the qualification will not be broken; the athletes advance to the final.*
