COMPETITION FORMAT	<p>Two mixed teams (Blue for Team Friendship and Red for Team Solidarity) from the four participating federations (MAG+WAG) will be formed by the coaches during the Coaches' Meeting where teams will be seeded to create balanced teams. Each team composed of up to 8 men and 8 women contain two gymnasts from the same federation for MAG and also for WAG. Gymnasts are not required to compete in the AA. There will be a final team score utilizing the top 3 scores on each apparatus for MAG and top 3 scores on each apparatus for WAG.</p> <p>Gymnasts will be permitted to perform two vaults, if desired. Only the 1st vault will count towards the team score.</p>

MEDICAL SERVICES	The LOC will provide emergency medical support and ambulance during the trainings and competition in the venue. To mitigate the risk of COVID-19 infection, the facilities will provide a safer environment than daily life.																																
VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Japanese Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Japan.</p> <p>The LOC will be happy to assist each delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made as soon as possible to the LOC/JGA.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>																																

INSURANCE	<p>IMSSA (International Medical & Security Sports Assistance) will provide ALL delegation members with an insurance program acquired through FIG. IMSSA is a subscriber of an Assistance and insurance Program with International SOS. The program number is 011500A.</p> <p>The program includes medical evacuation and repatriation services. This insurance covers medical and hospital expenses engaged up to CHF 1,000,000.00, as well as the organization and support of repatriation to the effective costs. Expenses related to infections of COVID-19 and the costs of administrative quarantine in Tokyo are also covered.</p> <p>Exclusions:</p> <p>In case the traveller was aware before his/her departure on the trip:</p> <p>A. of a prohibition to enter the country of destination without carrying out a quarantine B. a ban on returning to his country of residence without quarantine the services are null and void.</p> <p>The coverage is in accordance with the specifications as stipulated in the General Conditions Article 18.1.7 of the insurance contract.</p>

MEALS	All meals are the responsibility of LOC and will be served in the host hotel in a dedicated banquet room for delegations with appropriate social distancing. Food service will be individually and not by buffet. Times and locations to be given at accreditation.
JUDGES AND PANELS	A maximum of two judges from each federation with current valid FIG brevets are invited for each discipline. Additional judges will be provided by the JPN Federation. The judges' panels will be separated into two for MAG and two for WAG. The panel size should be 2D and 3E. The median of the 3E scores will be used for the final score. More than one judge from the same federation may be within the same judging panel or function (if necessary). Line, time, and secretary positions filled by JGA. The JGA will assign a President of the Superior Jury, will be of the highest available category for MAG and WAG.
Measures for Prevention and Control of the COVID-19	<p>The event documents for Medical Guidelines, Instructions for Health Monitoring and all updates will be strictly respected.</p> <p><u>The delegations are not permitted to leave the competition venue and host hotel, except for official transportation between the two locations.</u></p> <p>Note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each Delegation member needs to submit the result of 2 different PCR tests to FIG in advance of their entry in Japan at 2 weeks before and one week before. Printed results from a 3rd test within 72-hours of departure will need to be delivered upon arrival in Japan and may also be required by some airlines to travel. • PCR test will be conducted multiple times for Delegation and LOC members during the official period of training and competition Tokyo.
