SPECIFIC RULES FOR PARKOUR

Version 2.0 – April 2024 ~~Version 3.0 – December 2021~~

The specific rules listed below apply only to this discipline.

ARTICLE 1 JUDGES' ~~TEST~~COURSES

The Intercontinental and International Courses, will last one day course and one day examination. The Course will end with a practical examination on video.

Online examination lasts only one day.

1.1 Intercontinental Course~~Online Testing~~

Each Federation will be permitted to send a maximum of three (3) Judges to the Intercontinental Course.

No Minimum Category is required to participate

All judges who wish to raise or maintain their category must take the examination.

At the Intercontinental Course, there is no maximum number of judges from an individual federation that may achieve Category 1.

Category 1 may be achieved at the Intercontinental Judges' Course only.

1.2 International Courses~~Regional Courses~~

No minimum Category to participate. The number of judges is limited to 15 judges per Federation per course. Should places be available after the registration deadline, additional judges may be accepted among the judges registered by their federation as "reserves".

3 additional judges from the host

Participants are able to qualify up to Category 2

1.3 Retest Courses

This course will have a maximum of 35 participants. The course will be filled on a first come, first serve basis.

All NFs may register a maximum of 2 eligible judges, along with reserves. After the deadline, in case of remaining places, the course will be filled one by one by reserves from each NF based on a first come, first serve basis.

The Regional Judges' Courses (in-person) are organized by NFs, upon request and approval of FIG in 2023.

2.1 Summary of Evaluation Method for ~~Testing~~ Examination

This Summary of Evaluation Methods for Tests has been confirmed by the Parkour Commission.

The calculation of score for each run consists of the following steps: 1. Determine the deviation of each judge's individual evaluation from the expert score 2. Assignment of a percentage based on the deviation from the expert score (table below)	The final score will be the average percentage from all exercises.
Part 1- Execution Judging (12 scores for 12 video runs) Up to- 15 points for each run (candidates enter the 3 components, maximum 5 points each <u>final Execution score</u>)	6 men's runs 6 women's runs Average score from all runs
Part 2- Difficulty Judging (12 scores for 12 video runs) Up to- 15 points for each run (candidates enter the 3 components <u>best D score, maximum 5 points each</u>)	6 men's runs 6 women's runs Average score from all runs

Maximum time for evaluation is 90 seconds per video.

ARTICLE 3 CATEGORIES

~~3.1~~ — Category 1 Judge Qualification and Quota

The PKC must assure that enough Category 1 judges are selected to fulfill the necessary responsibilities required during the cycle.

- Category 1 judges will be qualified through the ~~2022-2024~~ judges' [test examination](#) results, ~~but only available to judges with experience at World Cups and/or World Urban Games during the 14th cycle (2017-2021).~~
- The only judges exempt from the ~~online tests~~[examination](#) are current Category 1 judges that created the test and educational materials. They will retain their brevets through ~~2024~~[2028](#), pending the approval by their respective NF.

~~Category 1 – Freestyle Difficulty for WCH, TWG & World Cups~~

~~Only Category 1 judges may evaluate Freestyle Difficulty at these competitions. All other judges can be drawn to Freestyle Execution and/or Time or Line positions for the Speed competitions.~~


