



FIG HONORARY AWARDS AND DISTINCTIONS RULES

Edition 2023

PREAMBLE

As per provided in the FIG Statutes, awards of special merit and distinctions for outstanding merits may be granted by the FIG to any person who has rendered outstanding service to the FIG or to the cause of Gymnastics internationally.

In compliance with and in addition to the provisions of the FIG Statutes, the present FIG Honorary Awards and Distinctions Rules shall apply. These Rules define the terms and conditions to grant such awards and distinctions.

As a general principle, awards and distinctions mentioned in these Rules may be only granted to a person who has no longer function within or related to FIG, or will cease his/her functions by the end of the year following the granting of the award.

1. AWARDS AND DISTINCTIONS

1.1 Awards of Special Merit

- Honorary President
- Honorary Vice-President
- Honorary Member

1.2 Distinctions for Outstanding Merits

- FIG Silver Distinction
- FIG Bronze Distinction

2. TERMS OF ATTRIBUTION

2.1 Honorary President

The award of Honorary President may be exclusively granted to a person who has been the President of the FIG for at least one (1) cycle.

2.2 Honorary Vice-President

The award of Honorary Vice-President may be exclusively granted to a person who has held the following positions :

- Vice-President for at least two (2) cycles;
- Technical Committee President or GfA Committee President for at least two (2) cycles; or
- FIG Secretary General for at least two (2) cycles.

2.3 Honorary Member

The award of Honorary Member may be granted to a person who has held the following positions:

- Technical Committee President or GfA Committee President for at least one (1) cycle;
- Executive Committee, Technical Committee or GfA Committee member for at least two (2) cycles; or
- FIG auditor for at least three (3) cycles.

The award of Honorary Member may also be granted to any other person who has collaborated with FIG during a long period of time and made an outstanding contribution to the development of Gymnastics internationally.

2.4 FIG Silver Distinction

The FIG Silver Distinction may be granted to a person who has held the following positions:

- Executive Committee, Technical Committee or GfA Committee member for at least for one (1) cycle;
- Council member for at least two (2) cycles; or
- FIG auditor for at least two (2) cycles.

The award of Honorary Member may also be granted to any other person who has rendered particularly outstanding service to the cause of Gymnastics internationally.

2.5 FIG Bronze Distinction

The FIG Bronze Distinction may be granted to a person who has held the position of Council member or FIG auditor for at least one (1) cycle.

3. ATTRIBUTION PROCESS

3.1 Attribution by the Congress

Pursuant to FIG Statutes, the following titles are awarded by the Congress upon the recommendation of the Executive Committee:

- Honorary President,
- Honorary Vice-President,
- Honorary Member.

The awardee shall be notified accordingly.

Honorary awards will be presented when/where a transfer ceremony is organised or at any other formal occasion.

3.2 Attribution by the Executive Committee

The FIG Silver distinction and the FIG Bronze Distinction are awarded by the Executive Committee.

The awardee shall be notified accordingly.

Distinctions for outstanding merits will be presented when/where a transfer ceremony is organised or at any other formal occasion.

4. PUBLICATION

The distinctions shall be mentioned in the FIG Bulletin and published on the FIG website Directory.

5. FINAL PROVISION


These Rules for Honorary FIG Awards and Distinctions have been approved by the FIG Executive Committee at its meeting in Dacca (BAN) in November 2023.
