FIG HONORARY COACHES' DIPLOMA

A coach receives the FIG Honorary Coaches' Diploma if he or she has participated as a national or a personal coach (with a coach's accreditation) at a minimum of eight FIG Competitions (Olympic Games, Youth Olympic Games, The World Games, World Championships- Sr. or Jr.).

The Coach must be nominated by a National Federation they represented at any of the competitions stated above, which must also provide the necessary documentation and proof (certificates, accreditation cards, etc.).

Exclusions from Nomination:

- The coach must not have of any FIG Disciplinary sanctions during their career. (Confirmation made by FIG);
- The coach may not have any convictions, regardless of the age of record, or current legal proceedings against them in relation to athlete safeguarding within the nominating federation/country where they have worked (Confirmation made by nominating federation).

FIG reserves the right to retract this diploma if any of the two points above are not properly observed, before or after the recognition is granted.

The National Federation must submit the name(s) of their coach(es) to sports@fig-gymnastics.org between 01 January and 28 February of each year for recognition in that given year. After verification by the Sports Department and respective TC President, if the conditions are met, the Secretary General submits the request to the Executive Committee for final approval.
